my names is Timothy Chenault,

My case is currently being reviewed by the
Court of Appeals Division II. I am writing
because I have a request. Sometime between now
and last August, my transcripts from my trial were
misplaced during my placement in segregation.
As you may know, those transcripts are most
important. I would like to request copies of the
trial transcripts once more, or information on how to
obtain them. Also I do not know the answer to this
question, but around the time my division sent me
the paperwork to state additional issues I was also
in segregation, my letter was put with my things, which
I received after the 30 day limit to file. I only had
1 issue I hoped to bring to light, it was in regards
to the photos collected by officer Nicholson. The error I
wish to bring to light was on the part of my attorney,
Mr. Byrd did not set a 3.6 hearing asking to suppress
these photos, though they were collected without a warrant,
also the cellphone by which the photos were taken of
was given back to the alleged victim who deleted the
contents within that cellphone. My argument is my
attorney allowed the photos to be admitted into trial, though
we were unable to examine the source of the photos,
also the jury was able to view photos that were

Taken with out consent, nor warrant. These photo
were used to give a sort of time line. So if I am not

argument made by myself.
