LINE 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, AND PAGE 217  
 LINE 1. OFFICER WURGES SAID THAT HE  
 DIDNT SEE ANY TORN UP CHECKS BY THE  
 GARBAGE CAN, PAGE 47 LINE 3, 4.

OFFICER HENSLEY TESTIFIED THAT HE DIDNT  
 SEE ANY RIPPED UP CHECKS (VOL 2 RP 71)  
 NOW OFFICER LOPEZ IS THE ONLY OFFICER  
 TO SEE CHECKS ON THE FLOOR, IN THE  
 GARBAGE CAN AND ON THE NIGHTSTAND,  
 THATS BECAUSE HE SEARCHED THE ROOM  
 AND PUT THE CHECKS (TORN UP CHECKS)  
 IN A POLICE EVIDENCE BAG, THATS  
 WHAT HE TESTIFIED TO, AND HE  
 DID NOT PUT EXHIBIT # 74 IN EVIDENCE  
 LIKE HE TESTIFIED HE DID, THEN PUT  
 THEM ON THE CHAIR LIKE HE DIDNT
