ORDER

25700-B- 464

The Court on September 7, 2006, considered the request of the Office of Public Defense (OPD) to increase the per page rate for preparation of verbatim report of proceedings for indigent review cases, where an appropriate order has been entered pursuant to RAP 15. The Court unanimously determined that a \$.30 per page increase to the \$2.80 per page rate funded by the Legislature is justified;

Now, therefore, it is hereby


ORDERED:

1. That pursuant to RAP 15.4(d), compensation for the preparation of an original and one copy of a verbatim report of proceedings for indigent review cases, where an appropriate order has been entered, will be increased to \$3.10 per page.

2. That the new per page rate of \$3.10 will be implemented by OPD upon the legislative appropriation of adequate funds to the OPD budget.
