

Appellant's substantial sole livelihood is derived from Commercial Fishing in the waters surrounding Kenai, Alaska. My Commercial Fishing Season begins on July 1, and terminates August 15, 2015. Appellant has been pledged to this business since the year 1965, and does not have other employment in which to rely upon. My fishing season, my vessel, and crew demands my utmost time and attention during the six week time frame of which the fish arrive to return to their spawning grounds. We are engaged 6 – 7 days a week, 18 – 20 hours a day, during the height of this season.

The Order Denying the Motion for Reconsideration was mailed on July 8, 2015, and arrived in my mailbox on July 15, 2015. Appellant has already 'lost' a week due to "snail mail," and now commencing into the pinnacle of my fishing season.

Appellant herby requests an extension of time to timely file for DISCRETIONARY REVIEW OF DECISION TERMINATING REVIEW, so that Appellant would be able to pursue his livelihood during this crucial time of the year.
