STATEMENT OF ADDITIONAL
GROUNDS FOR REVIEW

I, Jeffrey Weller, have received and reviewed the opening brief prepared by my attorney. Summarized below are the additional grounds for review that are not addressed in that brief. I understand the Court will review this Statement of Additional Grounds for Review when my appeal is considered on the merits.

Additional Ground 1

My NCO's of 10, 5, and 3 years to victims, at resentencing was lengthened to 30 years to all 4 victims. This is clearly excessive and way beyond the standard sentencing range. I am asking the court to reinstate the first NCO's of 10, 5, and 3 years as to CJ, CL, NW, EW.

I, Jeffrey Weller am asking the court if they will allow me to file the additional grounds that I have. I know this is late, but that's because after receiving this notification from the Court of Appeals, I was transported to Monroe, Twin Rivers Unit for surgery. I have a large cancerous tumor that needs to be removed. I haven't had the materials I needed, at the time to be able to send in for additional grounds, but I believe this to be very important. At trial on Feb 8, 2013 I was convicted of some crimes and at sentencing was given NCO's of 10 years as to EJ and CL, 5 years as to NW, and 3 years as to EW. At my resentencing, in September 2015, the court lengthened my NCO's to 30 years as to all 4 victims. This is way beyond legal or even reasonable years. My sentence ends June 2033 and my ERD is June 2026. The victims will be adults of 20+ years old. This NCO is clearly excessive and uncalled for. I am asking that the original 10, 5, and 3 year NCO's be reinstated. A 30 year NCO is unconstitutional and not necessary.
