APPELLANT'S MOTION FOR
DISCRETIONARY REVIEW

I am Sing Cho Ng, Appellant of the above-captioned action. This is my motion for discretionary review of the Order Denying My Motion to Modify the Commissioner's ruling entered in the above-captioned case. The following are the reasons.

(1) The COA dismissed of my #75751-2 appeal alleging that failed to file a designation of clerk's papers and statement of arrangements.

(2a) I am requesting a reconsideration of the dismissal because the panel judges were not fully informed of the facts.

(2b) It must be pointed out that ever since Commissioner Mary Neel, and Court Administrator Richard Johnson abused their official power to remove the genuine 18-Page-Set of documents electronically transmitted to COA on October 1, 2015 for my #74051-2 Notice of Appeal and ever since they followed by fraudulently inserting into the case file a forged set documents delivered over the counter by trial Judge Helson's balliff Grant on October 5

(2c) The penal judges were misinformed of the facts and were misled to deny my motion and to dismiss this COA #75751-2 (underlying KCSC 16-0-00051-7) appeal.

(3a) Yes, there had been a delay in the submission of the finished Clerk's Papers to the COA.

(3b) But the delay was due to a series of administrative confusions from 12/23/2016 through 3/23/2017 as described below.

(3c) On 5/22/2017, I filed a supplement motion to the KCSC 16-2-00051-7 requesting the superior court to clarify the confusion and requesting to re-send the relevant Clerk's Papers to the COA, a copy which with attachments was immediately filed with the COA on the same day.

(3d) Sub# documents cited below are referable in my 5/22/2017 filing with COA.

(4a) Please note that I requested Clerk's Papers on 12/23/2016. See Sub #18.

(4b) KCSC completed preparation on 1/3/2017. See Sub #20.

(4c) I submitted all required documents for waiver of fees respectively on 2/8/2017, 2/9/2017 and 3/13/2017. See Sub #20A, #21 & #22.

(4d) Trial judge granted ORDER TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS was granted on 3/22/2017. See Sub #23

(5a) Therefore, the delay was not due to my failure to request for preparation of the clerk's papers, and has been beyond my ability to control.

(5b) I have not yet filed statement of arrangements because of the delay of the submission of the Clerk's Papers.

(6a) I received a ruling, dated 2/1/2017, of the COA threatening to terminate my appeal. See COA 75751-2, Entry 02-01-17 Decision Filed and Entry 02-01-17 Ruling Terminating Review.

(6b) I moved, on 2/13/2017, to modify the ruling on reason that I had filed my request for the preparation to the clerk of the lower court. See COA 75751-2, Entry 02-13-17 Motion to Modify Ruling.

(6d) Immediately after receipt of the COA's letter, I served, for the second time, all documents I filed with the KCSC on the substitution attorney Loeffler Law Group.

(7a) The underlying KCSC 16-2-00051-7 action is a separate civil action.

(7b) After I was evicted from the New American Hotel from which I rented an SRO for my dwelling, the appellees unreasonably detained my left-behind property for more than two months.

(8a) As of right, I filed KCSC 16-2-00051-7 action for the delivery of the left-behind property.

(8b) The cause of action of this 16-2-00051-7 (COA #75751-2) is distinct from the 15-2-16467-8 (COA #74051-2, #74251-5 and #75854-3) action in which I am the defendant.

(8c) The cause of action of this 16-2-00051-7 is also distinct from the 15-2-30570-1 action in which I am suing several name identified individuals who unlawfully entered my dwelling in October 2014 by forcible means.

(8d) The underlying KCSC 16-2-00051-7 action did not stem from the 15-2-16467-8 eviction action because at least five insider-members of the defendant association were found to have spitted and taken home for their own uses of some of my left-behind property.

(8e) Further input of my side of the defense and legal theory is beyond the scope of this instant motion for discretionary review.

(9a) **THEREFORE**, I respectfully request call for righteous action(s) be taken to mitigate further damages.

(9b) **THEREFORE**, I request granting of discretionary review by Supreme Court.
