
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO

Instructions

There is no indication currently for antibiotics or more prednisone, though that can change. I recommend continuing your inhaler every four hours as needed, cough medicine as needed, and the sulindac for the chest wall pain, twice daily with food.

No smoking or other irritants; they will worsen cough both now and later
