App. Div. 1 March 30, 2020)³ (“Furthermore, and although **we have discretion to consider briefs from nonparties** under RAP 10.1(e) and (h), we do so on a case-by-case basis”; emphasis added) to show the Court’s has discretion in ruling on the motion re: proposed non-lawyer amicus brief herein.

Marion E. Pitch v. USA, No.1 7-15016 (11th Cir. Mar. 27, 2020) (en banc)⁴, interpreting Fed. R. Crim. P. 6(e) to see if there’s inherent, supervisory power to order disclosure in a situation not falling into one of the enumerated exceptions of the rule. Provided to potentially assist the Court with statutory construction of Washington RAP 10.6(a)⁵.
