I. IDENTITY OF MOVING PARTY AND RELIEF SOUGHT

I.A.S., the petitioner, asks this Court to consolidate the petition for review filed in his case with the petition filed in *State v. M.Y.G.*, Court of Appeals number 37240-5-III (petition filed Dec. 30, 2020, S.Ct. No. 99374-2). The Court of Appeals decided both cases in published opinions entered on the same day, addressing the same issue. It serves the ends of justice and judicial efficiency to join these cases for review.

II. GROUNDS FOR RELIEF SOUGHT

Petitioner I.A.S. appeals from the Court of Appeals decision ordering he submit to the collection of a biological

sample for DNA analysis at the time he entered a deferred disposition in juvenile court.

M.Y.G.'s case raises the identical legal issue. *State v.*M.Y.G., _ Wn. App. _, _ P.3d _, COA No. 37240-5-III, 2020 WL

7038617 (Dec. 1, 2020). M.Y.G.'s petition for review was filed on

December 30, 2020, S.Ct. No. 99374-2. The Court of Appeals

decided both cases on the same day, in published opinions. Both

decisions reach the same result but rest on "somewhat different

grounds" and were written by different judges from the Court of

Appeals. Slip op. at 2 n.2.

IV. ARGUMENT

The Rules of Appellate Procedure are liberally interpreted to promote justice and facilitate the decision of cases on the merits. RAP 1.2. RAP 3.3(b) authorizes the consolidation of cases for the purpose of review, when it saves time and expense and provides for a fair review of the cases.

The interest of justice favor consolidating I.A.S.'s case with M.Y.G.'s due to the overlapping issues, the interrelated arguments raised, and the benefit in having somewhat different analysis of the same issue.

Motion to Consolidate

Both cases raise significant issues in published decisions that merit this Court's consideration. The cases should be consolidated and review granted.

V. CONCLUSION

I.A.S. respectfully requests this Court consolidate his case with M.Y.G. and grant review in both cases.
