RE: 2014 Summary of changes to GR 34 forms

The Washington Pattern Forms Committee updated the following forms to implement Jafar v. Webb 177 Wash.2d 520, 303 P.3d 1042 (2013):

1. GR 34.0100, Motion and Declaration for Waiver of Civil Fees and Surcharges
2. GR 34.0200, Motion and Declaration for Waiver of Civil Fees and Surcharges (QLSP Filing)
3. GR 34.0500, Order Re Waiver of Civil Fees and Surcharges

The following table contains detailed descriptions of the changes:

1.	GR 34.0100	<p>Motion and Declaration for Waiver of Civil Filing Fees and Surcharges</p> <p>Change the form title as indicated above.</p> <p>In paragraph 1.2, after “waiver of” and before “fees,” delete “all filing.” At the end of the sentence, insert “under GR34.”</p> <p>In paragraph 2.1, at the beginning of the phrase in quotation marks, delete “filing.”</p> <p>In paragraph 3.1, in the first line, after “the” and before “fees,” delete “filing.”</p>
2.	GR 34.0200	<p>Motion and Declaration for Waiver of Civil Filing Fees and Surcharges (QLSP Filing)</p> <p>Change the form title as indicated above.</p>

		<p>In section I. Motion, in the first paragraph after “waiver of” and before “fees,” delete “all filing.” At the end of the paragraph, insert “under GR 34.”</p>
3.	GR 34.0500	<p>Order Re Waiver of Civil Filing Fees and Surcharges</p> <p>Change the form title as indicated above.</p> <p>In section I. Basis, after “waive” and before “fees,” delete “filing.”</p> <p>In section III. Order, In paragraph 3.1, in the first sub-check box option, after “all” and before “fees,” delete “filing.”</p> <p>Delete all of paragraph 3.3:</p> <p>3.3 — If there is a material change in financial circumstances, the ruling can be revisited by the court or the moving party.</p> <p>If the motion was granted and the court, upon review, later finds that either the petitioner or another responsible party to this proceeding has sufficient resources to pay the waived filing fees or surcharges, the Court may modify this order and require the moving party or another party to pay the filing fees and/or surcharges that have been waived by this order.</p>
