<b>1.</b>	GDN M 204 Motion for Immediate Order (Emergency Guardianship)	<p><u>Changed</u> “<b>Use this form</b> if you need <u>an order placing the children with you right now. cannot wait until the hearing on your <del>Motion or Petition.</del> If you use this form you do <b>not</b> need GDN M 206 Motion for Emergency Minor Guardianship.</u>” to clearly reflect that this Motion may be used without filing GDN M 206. Clarified what Orders to bring.</p> <p><u>Added</u> “Appointment of an emergency guardian is likely to prevent substantial harm to the children’s health, safety, or welfare AND no one else appears to have the authority, ability, and willingness to act to prevent the harm. Explain the risk of harm: <i>(Attach additional pages if necessary)</i> Explain why no one else has the authority, ability, and willingness to act:” to section 8 to ensure the legal standard for an emergency guardianship is covered in GDN M 204.</p>
<b>2.</b>	GDN M 501 Notice of Hearing to Change or End a Minor Guardianship	<p><u>Removed</u> the reference to a summons on the <i>Notice of Attachment</i>.</p>
<b>3.</b>	GDN R 206 Order Approving Guardian or Conservator’s Report	<p><u>Corrected</u> clerk’s action paragraph numbers.</p>
