



## Domestic Relations and Family Law Forms Summary of Changes

### Form Changes – July 23, 2023

<b>1.</b>	FL All Family 146 Order Appointing a Guardian ad Litem for a Child	<p>Gender neutral changes.</p> <p><u>Removed</u> reference Non-Parental Custody option.</p> <p>The following changes were made to section 5 and are based on a comment from DCYF re: its ability to release records when only “[ ] All issues related to making a parenting plan for these children,” is checked:</p> <p>“All issues related to making a parenting plan for these children <u>including any of the issues below whether they are specifically checked or not:</u></p> <p><u>[ ] Only the issues that are checked below.”</u></p> <p><u>Added</u> “All providers for the parents related to issues the GAL is ordered to investigate including mental health and substance abuse records where applicable.” to section 7 to address release of records about the parents.</p> <p><u>Added</u> the following to section 8:</p> <p>“The signatures of parties or children 12 or older below mean they give permission to the agencies and professionals listed in <b>7</b> above to share information <u>related to the issues the GAL is ordered to investigate</u> about themselves and the children with the GAL.”</p>
<b>2.</b>	FL All Family 150 Restraining Order	<p><u>Added</u> “all firearms, dangerous weapons, and concealed pistol licenses in the parties’ custody, control, or possession” to Immediately Surrender to law enforcement.</p> <p><u>Added</u> paragraph mark and created three bullets in the prohibit weapons portion of section 5 to address changes caused by HB 1715 to RCW 9.41.800.</p>
<b>3.</b>	FL All Family 154 Motion to Restrict Abusive Litigation	<p><u>Changed</u> intimate partner language.</p>

<p><b>4.</b></p>	<p>FL Divorce 211  Response to a Pt.  about a Marriage  FL Parentage 321, FL  Parentage 332, FL  Parentage 342, FL  Parentage 382, FL  Modify 602, FL  Relocate 722</p>	<p><u>Added</u> the following language, if relevant, to comply with changes caused by HB 1715 to RCW 9.41.800 to the prohibit weapons portion in section 3:  “To immediately surrender any firearms, other dangerous weapons, and any concealed pistol licenses that <u>they have in their custody, control, or possession to</u> <del>they possess to...</del>”</p> <p><u>Added</u> an option to revoke a joinder.</p>
<p><b>5.</b></p>	<p>FL Divorce 221 Motion  for Immediate  Restraining Order, FL  Divorce 223,  FL Parentage 321,  FL Parentage 323, FL  Modify 321, FL Modify  323</p>	<p><u>Added</u> to the appropriate section:  “Order my spouse/domestic partner to immediately surrender any firearms, other dangerous weapons, or concealed pistol licenses that they <del>possess or</del> <u>have in their custody, control, or possession to...</u>”</p> <p><u>Added</u> the following language to comply with changes caused by HB 1715 to RCW 9.41.800 to the prohibit weapons portion:  “Immediately surrender any firearms, other dangerous weapons, or concealed pistol licenses that they <del>possess or</del> <u>have in their custody, control, or possession to...</u>”</p>
<p><b>6.</b></p>	<p>FL Divorce 231  Findings and  Conclusions about a  Marriage</p>	<p><u>Added</u> “by clear and convincing evidence” to the invalidity portion of section 6.</p>
<p><b>7.</b></p>	<p>FL Modify 521 Motion  to Adjust Child  Support</p>	<p><u>Added</u> “<i>Use this form if at least 24 months have passed since the last child support order and the <b>only</b> reasons for your requests are that the parents’ income, the economic table, or child support standards have changed. Otherwise use Petition to Modify Child Support (FL Modify 501).</i>”</p>
