



Felony Judgement and Sentence Summary of Changes

Form Changes related to legislation. All previous no contact orders have been pulled and a new form takes its place.

1.	CR 08.0660 No-Contact Order	<u>Changed</u> references to statutes and form names to reflect changes caused by HB 1320 (2021) and HB 1901 (2022).
2.	CR 84.400 FJS Jail One year or less sex offense, One year or less non-sex offense, Prison (sex offense), Prison non-Sex offense, SOSSA	<u>Removed</u> payment of community custody fees from section 4.2 (b) (9) as a result of the passage of HB 1818. <u>Changed</u> 9.94A.703 striking the language to pay supervision fees as determined by the department under waivable conditions. Struck a similar provision in the SOSSA form.
3.	CR 84.400 FJS (All)	<u>Added</u> reference to DV statute. RCW 7.105.450(1)(b). to the section dealing with fines.
4.	NC 2.0100 – New Form	No Contact Order
5.	NC 02.0500	Protected Person’s Motion to Modify or Rescind No Contact Order <u>Added</u> a section about the measures the protected persons have taken to address their personal safety and public safety.
6	NC 02.0600	Notice of Hearing (for Protected Person’s Motion to Modify/Rescind No-Contact Order) <u>Updated</u> the hearing language.
7	NC 02.0700 and NC 02.0800	Order Denying Hearing and Order re Motion to Modify/Rescind No-Contact Order <u>Formatting</u> changes only.
