Court of Appeals Highlights

Filings

- Statewide, 4,188 cases were filed in the Court of Appeals during 2000. Division I, located in Seattle and serving Northwestern Washington, received 1,996 cases--47.7% of the total Court of Appeals caseload. Division II, located in Tacoma and serving Southwestern Washington, followed, with 1,370 cases (32.7%). Division III, located in Spokane and serving Eastern Washington, made up the remaining 19.6% of the statewide caseload with the 822 new filings they received in year 2000.
- Approximately three-quarters of Court of Appeal filings are appeals, which are split fairly evenly between civil (1,559 cases) and criminal (1,528 cases) matters. The remainder of filings at this court level are made up of personal restraint petitions (17.0% of total filings) and notices of discretionary review (9.3%).
- Following 1999's 8.9% decline in filings compared with the prior year, 2000 saw a 4.0% increase over the 1999 level statewide, with Division I experiencing a 4.6% increase and Division II experiencing a 9.8% increase. However, Division III's total filings dropped 5.6% in 2000.
- While the Division II increase was experienced across all case types, Division I experienced it only in civil appeals and personal restraint petitions. Division I criminal appeals continued their general downward trend of the last few years, and notices of discretionary review declined a modest 11 cases, from 1999's 167 filings to 2000's 156. Although Division III's total filings dropped, its civil appeals increased 7.2%.

Dispositions

- The Court of Appeals disposed of 4,238 cases statewide in 2000. This is down 5.1% from the prior year.
- The divisions contributed to statewide dispositions in approximately the same proportions as was true for filings, with Division I's 2,006 making up 47.3% of total dispositions, Division II's 1,335 dispositions making up 31.5%, and Division III's 897 dispositions making up 21.2%.
- Although Division III disposed of 15.2% fewer cases in 2000 than in 1999, this decline was tied to a drop in filings. In fact, in 2000, Division III was able to dispose of 9.1% more cases than they had new filings--primarily due to disposition of 358 criminal appeals while only 279 new ones were received. Division I's similar disposal of more criminal appeals than were newly filed (769 dispositions vs. 702 filings) was offset by their receipt of more new civil appeals (784) than dispositions during that same period (721), resulting in total dispositions (2,006) fairly comparable to incoming caseload (1,996). Division II, with 1,370 filings, received 2.6% more new cases than the number they disposed in 2000 (1,335).
- Nearly half (44.2%) of all dispositions were by opinion, with approximately a quarter (24.9%) of those opinions published. Approximately one-third (34.6%) of dispositions were dismissals. Commissioners' rulings accounted for 15.2%. The

remaining 6.0% of dispositions were transferred/certified, not accepted, or terminated.

Pending

- While pending caseload decreased in Division III (corresponding to their disposition of more cases than were newly filed during 2000), pending cases increased in both Divisions I (2.5%) and II (6.1%).
- Statewide, the majority of cases pending at the end of 2000 were awaiting parties' briefs (60.5%). Opinions/orders were in process for 269 (6.7%) of pending cases. The remainder were stayed or awaiting hearing.

Time In Process

- Time-in-process from filing to opinion shortened in the Court of Appeals, for both criminal and civil appeals. This continues the downward trend achieved since 1998.
- Statewide, 75% of criminal appeals received an opinion within 637 days-a 4.6% decrease over 1999's 668 days.
- Similarly, 75% of civil appeals received an opinion within 570 days-a decrease of 3.6% over the prior year's 591 days.

Note:

Due to time lag between filing a notice of appeal in trial court and appellate court receipt of the case, current year filings are slightly under-counted (roughly 2 percent). Previous year filings will be recalculated annually to include all cases received late. Although this will provide more accurate statistical reporting, it may cause current year filing totals to vary in future court reports.

Court of Appeals Glossary

This glossary is included to assist in understanding the statistical tables.

Filings

Notice of Appeal - The filing of an appeal of a trial court final judgment that is reviewable as a matter of right. Notices of appeal must be filed within 30 days of the trial court judgment. Unless otherwise prohibited by statute or court rule, a party may appeal from only trial court decisions as specified in Rules of Appellate Procedure (RAP) 2.2. Notices of appeal are categorized into criminal and civil appeals.

Personal Restraint Petition - The filing of a review to seek relief from limitations on a person's freedom due to current or imminent confinement, or other restrictions imposed by a criminal or civil trial court decision (RAP 16.4).

Discretionary Review - The filing of a review of interlocutory orders of a trial court, made prior to a final determination of the case, concerning whether errors or substantial departure from accepted and usual courses of proceedings occurred in the case. Unless otherwise prohibited by statute or court rule, a party may seek discretionary review of any act of superior court not appealable as a matter of right (RAP 2.3).

The appellate court may reverse, affirm, or modify the decision being reviewed and take any other action as the merits of the case and the interest of justice may require (RAP 12.2). Each review is counted as being disposed as soon as a decision terminating review is filed with the appellate clerk.

Opinions - The statement by the court of the decision reached in regard to a cause argued before it, expounding the law as applied to the case, and detailing the reasons upon which the judgment is based.

Opinions Published - The published written opinion terminating the review.

Opinions Unpublished - The unpublished written opinion terminating the review.

Commissioners' Rulings - Rulings by commissioners which terminate review.

Motion on the Merits - Termination of a review due to the granting of a motion on the merits (RAP 18.14).

Other Rulings - Other rulings by commissioners, such as rulings on accelerated review of adult sentences or juvenile offender proceedings or granting a motion to dismiss--Anders (RAP 15.2(h)).

Dismissed - An order issued by the court dismissing the review prior to the point where case merit is determined. The commissioner or clerk may dismiss a review for failure to comply with procedures. The court, on motion of a party, may dismiss a review for want of prosecution, if the review is frivolous, moot or solely for the purpose of delay, or for failure to comply with procedures (RAP 18.9).

Transferred/Certified - The Supreme Court, to promote orderly administration of

justice may, on its own initiative or on motion of a party, transfer a case from the Court of Appeals to the Supreme Court ("certified"). A case may be transferred from one division to another within the Court of Appeals (RAP 4.1, 4.2, 4.3, RCW 2.06.030).

Review Not Accepted - Reviews may not be accepted if they do not meet the conditions governing the acceptance of review (RAP 2.2, 2.3, and 16.4).

Other Terminations - An order issued by the court terminating the review before an opinion is rendered. An order to terminate a review would result if, for example, a petitioner decided to withdraw the review.

Pending Cases

Case Stayed - Those cases temporarily arrested or removed from judicial processing by order of the court.

Brief Not Filed - Those cases within the stages of perfection in which no briefs have yet been filed.

Appellant Brief Filed - Those cases within the stages of perfection in which appellant's brief has been filed, but respondent's brief is still awaited.

Respondent Brief Filed - Those cases within the stages of perfection in which both appellant's brief and respondent's brief have been filed, but case has yet to be set on the court calendar for review.

Remanded to Trial Court - Those cases whose jurisdiction have been temporarily returned to the trial court of origination.

Set for Motion on the Merits - Those cases which have progressed to the point at which all briefs were filed and served, and now qualify for setting. Because a motion on the merits has been made, these cases have been set on the Motion on the Merits calendar (RAP 18.14).

Ruling Referred to Panel - Cases which were initially assigned to a commissioner, who has ruled that they should be referred to a panel of judges for a decision.

Set for Oral Argument - Those cases which have progressed to the point at which all briefs were filed and served and have been set for a review.

Opinion/Order in Process - Those cases which have been reviewed by the court but have yet to receive a decision.

Mandated

A review is mandated by the clerk of the Court of Appeals when a written notification, when required, is sent to the trial court and all parties. The notification informs all parties of an appellate court decision terminating the review.

Time In Process Statistics--Notices Of Appeal

NOTE: The time-in-process model, data entry, and statistical measurement changed substantially in 1998, and are not comparable to stages published in prior years.

Filing - The date the appeal is filed in the trial court.

Statement of Arrangements - The date of the first occurrence when the Statement of Arrangements has either been "Received" or "Filed" in the appellate court.

Completion of Record - The date transcripts and report of proceedings are complete, at which time the due date is set for the appellant's brief.

Appellant's Brief - The date of the last occurrence for the Appellant's Brief to either be "Filed" or "Received." The latter is recorded when the report is returned from the printer. Note: For statistical purposes "Received" is only employed when "Filed" is omitted.

Ready - The date on which the case is ready to go to a panel of judges. A civil case is ready when respondent's brief is filed or, in a cross-appeal, when the cross-respondent's reply brief is filed (or deemed not filed). A criminal case is ready when respondent's brief is filed and no notice of intent to file supplemental briefs has been filed. When a notice of intent is filed, the case is ready when the pro se supplemental brief is filed or when 60 days has expired.

Opinion - The date of the last occurrence of the filing of the opinion.
