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I. ASSIGNMENTS OF ERROR AND RELATED ISSUES

Assignment of Error: The trial court erred when it affirmed the King County Board of Appeals denial of Daljit Sangha's for hire license based on his driving record.

Issue No. 1: Whether the Board of Appeals erred in concluding that the change in Daljit Sangha's driving record in the renewal period (calendar year 2013) warranted denial of a renewal of his for hire license.

Issue No. 2: Whether the Superior Court erred in affirming the Board of Appeals' decision.

II. STATEMENT OF THE CASE

A. Nature of Proceedings

Daljit Sangha has served in King County and the City of Seattle as a licensed for-hire driver since 2007. King County, through its Records and Licensing Services Division conducts annual renewals of for-hire licenses, and renewed Mr. Sangha's for-hire license each and every year up until its decision to deny the renewal on January 28, 2014, subsequently affirmed by the King County Board of Appeals on March 31, 2014.

Mr. Sangha timely appealed the King County Board of Appeals decision to King County Superior Court. On January 9, 2015, the Honorable Douglass A. North issued an order affirming the King County

Board of Appeals decision based on Mr. Sangha's driving record, but not on the basis of any alleged misrepresentation. Mr. Sangha timely appealed to this Court. King County has not appealed the portion of the Superior Court's order "not upholding the finding of misrepresentation." Accordingly, the only issue before this Court is whether the Board of Appeals and Court erred in concluding that Mr. Sangha's driving record justified a decision not to renew the for-hire license.

B. Statement of Facts

The facts in this case are undisputed. In 2013, based on Mr. Sangha's driving record up to and including calendar year 2012, King County renewed Mr. Sangha's for-hire license. Accordingly, the only portion of Mr. Sangha's driving record relevant to King County's decision to deny Mr. Sangha's a renewal in 2014 is his driving record in 2013.

The only incident at issue since the last for-hire license renewal occurred on April 19, 2013. King County concluded that Mr. Sangha was involved in an "at-fault" accident on that date, but the record is devoid of any finding of fault. Rather, the record only establishes that: "On April 19, 2013, Mr. Sangha while operating a taxicab was cited for an at fault accident." (King County Board of Appeals Written File, *Daljit Sangha v. King County Records and Licensing Services Division*, Case BA14-602). See Appendix A at pp 14.

III. ARGUMENT

1. This Court Reviews the Commission's Legal Conclusions *De Novo*, Applying the "Error of Law" Standard.

The Appellate Court stands "in the same position as the superior court when reviewing an administrative decision." *Swoboda v. Town of La Conner*, 97 Wash.App. 613, 617, 987 P.2d 103 (1999), *review denied*, 140 Wash.2d 1014, 5 P.3d 9 (2000), and applies "the appropriate standard of review directly to the administrative record." *Boehm v. City of Vancouver*, 111 Wash. App. 711, 716, 47 P.3d 137, 141 (2002) (citing *Wilson v. Employment Sec. Dep't*, 87 Wash.App. 197, 200, 940 P.2d 269 (1997)).

It is well-established that: "In reviewing the actions of administrative agencies, the courts in determining the competency and sufficiency of the evidence before the agency commonly express the test to be applied in terms of whether, based on the entire record, the agency's action was arbitrary or capricious." *Andrew v. King County*, 21 Wash.App. 566, 575, 586 P.2d 509 (1978) (citing *Helland v. King County Civil Service Commission*, 84 Wn.2d 858, 862, 529 P.2d 1058 (1975); *Dulmage v. Seattle*, 19 Wash.App. 932, 935, 578 P.2d 875 (1978)). In this way, the test is essentially the same as the test for the competency and sufficiency of evidence expressed in the certiorari statute. RCW 7.16.120(4) and RCW 7.16.120(5).

The King County Board of Appeal's findings of fact are properly reviewed by this Court to determine whether they are supported by "substantial evidence in light of the whole record, *i.e.*, evidence sufficient to persuade a fair-minded person of their truth." *City of Federal Way v. Public Employment Relations Commission*, 93 Wash.App. 509, 970 P.2d 752 (1998).

2. The King County Board of Appeals Did Not Have Competent and Sufficient Evidence Adequate To Conclude That The April 19, 2013 Citation For Involvement In An Accident Was Adequate To Deny Renewal Of Mr. Sangha's For Hire License.

The King County Board of Appeals concluded that Mr. Sangha was at fault for the April 19, 2013 motor vehicle accident in which he was involved based solely on the citation issued by a Washington State Trooper who was not present at the time of the accident, but instead generated a report after the fact. (King County Board of Appeals Written File, *Daljit Sangha v. King County Records and Licensing Services Division*, Case BA14-602). *See Appendix A at pp 17 - 23*. This is not adequate evidence upon which to establish fault, and reliance upon it to deny renewal of a for-hire license is arbitrary and capricious.

IV. CONCLUSION

King County denied Mr. Sangha a renewal of his for-hire license based on a determination that he was at fault for the April 19, 2013 motor vehicle accident. This determination was based solely on a citation issued after the accident, and not upon any other competent evidence. Accordingly, the decision is arbitrary and capricious and should be overturned.

This matter came before the Board of Appeals for King County on March 19, 2014, on the appeal of Daljit Sangha of a Notice and Order issued by the Licensing Manager of King County Licensing.

The Appellant, Daljit Sangha, appeared and was represented by Dawn Gearhart. Sean Cockbain, License Inspector, represented King County Licensing Section. Deputy Director, Megan Pedersen, was present at the hearing.

I.
STATEMENT

A Notice and Order of Denial of For-Hire Driver License FH# 14416 was issued January 28, 2014, to Daljit Sangha denying the Appellant's application for renewal of his King County/City of Seattle endorsed for-hire driver's license.

II.
FACTS AND CONTENTIONS

1. All parties to this action have been given notice as is required by the Ordinances of King County and by the Rules of the Board of Appeals.
2. All the procedural requirements to perfect this appeal have been fulfilled.
3. On December 4, 2013, the Appellant applied to renew his King County/City of Seattle endorsed for-hire driver's license. Pursuant to King County Code (KCC) 6.64.590, a copy of this Washington State Department of Licensing driving record was obtained. The record revealed the following traffic violations:


4. The Appellant listed two (2) not at fault accidents and two (2) traffic violations on his application.
5. KCC 6.64.600 A.1 states that the director shall deny any for-hire application if the applicant has made any material misstatements on his/her application.
6. KCC 6.64.600 B.2. and 3. The director may deny any for-hire application if the applicant has had past conduct while operating a taxicab or a past driving record that would lead the director to reasonably conclude that the applicant would not operate the taxicab in a safe manner.
7. The Appellant began driving a taxicab in 2007. He contends that he did not intentionally leave off violations on his application. He feels he is not an unsafe driver and he has had no new incidents.

III.
HOLDING

After weighing the evidence and testimony presented by the parties, as well as the applicable King County Codes, the Board UPHOLDS King County Licensing's' January 28, 2014, Notice and Order, finding that the Licensing Manager acted in accordance with the above referenced King County Codes.



1. Appeal of Daljit Sangha
2. This statement is in protest of the denial of my for-hire license renewal application.
 - a. Order of license denial, County/City of Seattle endorsed for-hire driver's license FH #14416.
 - b. I have operated a taxicab in Seattle for nearly 7 years. During that time I have modeled an exemplary driving record, and provided a vital service to the citizens of King County. I review my motor vehicle record (MVR) which lists a citation for improper vehicle registration. I simply forgot to list the accident on my renewal application because it appears in a separate section of the MVR. Operating a taxicab is my family's sole source of income. I support my wife, and am working to put my two children through college. A denial of my license is effectively a denial of my ability to work and a negation of the investment I've made in this business. I accept responsibility for the mistake of not listing the citation, but ask that you take the severity of this denial in to consideration.
 - c. I have been at fault in two accidents. The first accident on September 7, 2012 was caused when I lost consciousness while driving due to a medical condition. I have attached the police report. The second accident on April 19th, 2013 was a minor fender bender where a vehicle struck my car as I signaled and attempted to merge. I have completed the Level 2 Washington 8-hour defensive driving course. The certificate of completion is enclosed.
3. As relief, I would seek an overturn of the initial decision made to deny my for-hire license renewal, and ask that my license be renewed for 2014.
 - a. I have operated my taxicab with express regard for the safety of others.
 - b. I omitted a single traffic violation by mistake and did not intend to make a material misstatement on my application.
 - c. I meet all qualifications of the for-hire driver
 - d. I have done my best to comply with the provisions of the chapter related to vehicle requirements and the safe operation of the vehicle
 - e. I operate my taxicab in a safe manner

- f. My honesty, character, personal habits, past conduct and general qualifications show my ability and skill as a driver.







I carefully reviewed the above five at fault moving violation police reports. The application asks, "Have you had any moving traffic violations or accidents within the last 24 months including deferred, dismissed, tickets at fault/not at fault, pending or other status? and if yes, list below." Concealing a material fact or knowingly making a false statement on your application is an offense directly related to your honesty, integrity and character, which also reflects negatively on your suitability to operate as a for-hire driver (reference KCC 6.64.610 B.3. and KCC 6.64.620). Your failure to disclose on your application all of your moving traffic violations constitute a material misstatement KCC 6.64.600 A.1.

Failure to appeal within this seven-(7) day period will constitute a waiver of all rights to an administrative hearing and determination of the matter.

On December 14, 2013, Mr. Daljit Sangha, FH # 11416 applied to renew his King County/City of Seattle endorsed for hire license. After reviewing Mr. Sangha's driving record and related police reports, a notice and order of denial was issued on January 28, 2014. Mr. Sangha's license was denied based on the following King County Codes...

6.64.600 A.1 states that the director shall deny any for-hire application if the applicant has made any material misstatements on his application.

6.64.600 B.2. and 3. The director may deny if the applicant has had past conduct while operating a taxicab or a past driving record that would lead the director to reasonably conclude that the applicant would not operate the taxicab in a safe manner.

Mr. Sangha listed 2 not at fault accidents and 2 traffic violations on his application. In addition, he has had the following 5 accidents and/or tickets:

On April 19, 2013, Mr. Sangha while operating a taxicab was cited for an at fault accident.

September 7, 2012, Mr. Sangha while operating a taxicab, passed out and collided with a high voltage transformer.

March 6, 2012, Mr. Sangha while operating a taxicab and was issued a citation for Negligent Driving 2. He was observed by a police officer following cars and a school bus within 1 car length, traveling at a high rate of speed, not using his turn signals, and making unsafe lane changes. He was convicted of Negligent Driving 2 on August 16, 2012.

December 15, 2011, Mr. Sangha while operating a taxicab with a passenger hit a traffic circle and was cited for speeding and inattention to driving.

December 9, 2011, Mr. Sangha while operating a taxicab with a passenger and was issued a citation for speeding.







This incident took place on a public road in the County of King, State of Washington. I was operating a discreetly marked SeaTac Police traffic car and wearing full SeaTac Police uniform. I was on duty as a King County Sheriff Deputy, assigned to the City of SeaTac Police Traffic Unit. The speedometer of my patrol vehicle was calibrated/certified and I was using moving RADAR which displayed my vehicle speed.

Narrative:

I observed the listed vehicle traveling southbound on Interstate-5 (I-5). I was southbound on I-5 approaching Mile 158 (S Boeing Access RD exit) in the inside non-HOV lane traveling at about 60 MPH, the posted speed limit. The listed vehicle was lane #1, the outside lane of travel, when it sped past me at a high rate of speed. The vehicle came upon traffic and moved into lane #2, failing to signal until it had already crossed the lane divider. The vehicle accelerated passing one vehicle and then quickly came upon traffic. The listed vehicle began following this vehicle within just one car length while now traveling at about 60 MPH. The listed vehicle then moved into lane #3 just ahead of me. There was traffic in this lane as well preventing the listed vehicle from speeding back up again. The listed vehicle followed the car ahead of it within one car length for several blocks and then moved back into lane #2 where it got back behind the same car it had previously been following, still within about one car length. As we neared the exit to MLK JR WY S (mile 157) the listed vehicle moved into the outside lane and quickly accelerated passing traffic. I was able to accelerate to 70 MPH before I came upon traffic and had to slow. During this time the listed vehicle still quickly pulled away from me as I traveled at 10 MPH over the speed limit. I was not able to safely move to the outside lane to follow, but was able to maintain visual observations of the vehicle as it too had to slow for track after it had passed about 6 cars. After passing the exit to MLK JR WY S I was able to move to the outside lane, lane #1, and accelerate to catch up with the listed vehicle which was now traveling at about 60 MPH and within one car length of the vehicle ahead of it. As we near the exit to Interurban AV S (mile 156) the listed vehicle moved into lane #2 where there were two school buses ahead of it. While I could not clearly see the lead bus, the bus the listed vehicle was immediately behind was occupied by small (elementary school aged)

children. The listed vehicle followed the bus for about one block within half a car length of the bus at which point I began moving behind the listed vehicle to stop it for reckless driving as the driver was clearly operating the vehicle with a willful and wanton disregard for the safety of others. Just as I was getting behind the listed vehicle it accelerated and moved into lane #3 coming within just feet of the school bus in lane #2 and forcing the vehicle it had cut off in lane #3 to quickly brake/slow to avoid a collision. I moved to lane #3 behind the cutoff vehicle and then into lane #4 where I was able to accelerate up to 75 MPH as I tried to catch up to and stop the listed vehicle. At 75 MPH I did not gain on the listed vehicle at all until it came upon traffic and slowed to about 65 MPH as it moved over to what was now lane #2, the exit lane to westbound SR-518. As I moved over getting behind the listed vehicle it abruptly and without signaling moved over the solid white line going into lane #1 (exit only lane to S 154 ST). The listed vehicle accelerated past the vehicle now ahead of me in lane #2 and then moved back into my lane as we exited off of I-5, once again failing to signal. Once off SR-518 I was able to get behind the vehicle as we neared the exit to SeaTac Intl Airport/S 154 ST. The posted speed limit here was 60 MPH, but I was able to pace the vehicle for about one block at 71 MPH.

I activated my lights stopping the vehicle for reckless driving just as we exited towards SeaTac Intl Airport/S 154 ST. I contacted the driver, who was operating a Yellow Cab taxi, and identified him by his WA driver license. There were no other occupants in the vehicle. When I asked why the driver had been operating his vehicle in this manner he did not respond. I asked several more times still with no response. I asked the driver if he spoke English and he now responded telling me that he did. I asked the driver again why he had been driving in this manner and he explained that he was on his way to pick up a customer at SeaTac Intl Airport. The driver told me that he was supposed to be at the airport by 1200 hrs. I requested insurance and vehicle registration for the listed vehicle. Driver provided both documents, but upon closer examination I saw the vehicle registration provided belonged to a vehicle bearing WA license ABE5782. I issued the driver an infraction for Negligent Driving-2 and failing to carry the proper vehicle registration (2Z0256017). I provided the driver a copy of the infraction and he quickly sped away heading towards the airport. I realized I had not entered the address for King County District Court so I completed this new infraction (2Z0256018) and sent it to the court for mailing to the listed driver, citing him for Negligent Driving-2 as he was operating the vehicle in a manner he knew or should have known to be likely to cause harm to other persons/property and for failing to carry the proper vehicle registration.

The RADAR was being used in Moving Mode. I was using a Kustom Golden Eagle speed measuring device #E-31364. This RADAR unit was calibrated by Wescom and it has been certified to be in proper working order through 03-16-2012. I have been trained and qualified in the use of RADAR/LIDAR speed measuring devices by the Washington Criminal Justice Training Commission. This RADAR unit was checked both internally and by the assigned tuning forks #22823 (30 mph) and #24162 (55 mph), before and after the stop. The Patrol Speed indicator of the RADAR system was consistent with speedometer of my patrol vehicle. The RADAR unit appeared to be working properly.






