
COMES NOW the appellant Bradley R. Marshall and submits the following additional authorities to the Court pursuant to RAP 11.4:

- Marshall Exhibit 130; TR 1345 (Perryman admits his fee agreement in *Jeffries* was the same as his fee agreement in *Collins* wherein which he received 5% of any recovery from the plaintiffs and billed Marshall/Wheeler separately for any services he performed as an expert witness or consultant).
- TR 1105-06 (Bar Association dismissed grievance against Wheeler and Marshall in *Collins* case where it alleged they split fee with Perryman).
