In the course of the oral argument on the above-referenced case on Tuesday, September 19, 2006, I was asked questions by several of the justices regarding the time line in the case for invoices sent by David Tingey to the Haischs.


As promised in the argument, we provide the following information for the Court:

David Tingey sent an invoice to the Haischs shortly after December 27, 1994, the last day upon which he provided legal services to the Haischs, showing a balance due to him from the Haischs of \$14,657.98. This fact is acknowledged in the Haischs' Court of Appeals brief at page 9. Mr. Tingey's work on the Grant County case in which he defended the Haischs concluded in December of 1994. The present action was commenced in the Grant County Superior Court on December 13, 1999. CP 1-14. The trial court rejected the Haischs' affirmative defenses and their offset arguments. CP 160.

I hope that this information answers the Court's questions regarding the factual time line in this case. If we can provide further information to the Court, please do not hesitate to let us know. Best regards.
