RESPONDENT'S STATEMENT
OF ADDITIONAL AUTHORITY

Pursuant to RAP 10.8, respondent cites the following additional authority on the question whether the government must establish the knowing, intelligent and voluntary waiver of constitutional rights, rather than presume the waiver of constitutional rights: City of Seattle v. Klein, ___ Wn.2d ___, ___ P.3d ___ (No. 79973-3, September 13, 2007); slip op. at 10 ("In short, there is no presumption of waiver. In fact, our case law mandates that waiver must be affirmatively proved by the State"); at 18 ("In the criminal context, due process requires that a criminal defendant be given notice prior to deprivation of a substantial right").
