

State v. Leffler, slip opinion 34019-4-II (08/21/07) (the presence of "strong chemical smells" coming from a property where there is a neighboring home "at least within 200 feet" of the property does not authorize a performance safety assessment under the emergency exception to the search warrant requirement to "mak[e] sure that there is not an active cook or some sort of chemical reaction going on that could erupt into flame or explode." - No imminent threat of harm to any specific person).
