I. ARGUMENT

The Respondent Michael King filed a brief in this matter in Division I of the Court of Appeals on October 27, 2006. Respondent also filed errata to pages v and 38 of said brief on November 12, 2006. The present brief, however, contains two inaccuracies that Respondent Michael King wishes to correct. 
