The Respondent, Department of Corrections (Department), by and through its attorneys, ROBERT M. MCKENNA, Attorney General, and KIMBERLY D. FRINELL, Assistant Attorney General, hereby responds to the Personal Restraint Petition (PRP) of Vernon Jackson.

I. BASIS FOR INCARCERATION

Vernon Jackson, DOC #283484, is currently in the custody of the Department at the Washington State Penitentiary¹ pursuant to a valid judgment and sentence entered in Pierce County Superior Court Cause No. 81-1-01316-5. Exhibit 1, Declaration of Cherrie Kollmer, Attachment A, Legal Face Sheet, Offender Management Network Information system (OMNI). Under this cause number, Mr. Jackson was convicted of First Degree Robbery. Id. Mr. Jackson is currently incarcerated as a result of a

parole violation and his release date is uncertain. Id. Mr. Jackson is not challenging his underlying conviction in this action. See PRP.

II. STATEMENT OF FACTS

On December 3, 2007,² Mr. Jackson was charged with violating WAC 137-28-260 (606), "Possession, introduction or transfer of any tobacco, tobacco products, matches, or tobacco paraphernalia."³ Exhibit 2, Declaration of Brenda Murphy, Attachment B, Initial Serious Infraction Report. The initial serious infraction report stated that during the course of a head quarter's special investigation it was determined that a staff member who was involved in trafficking tobacco into MICC had been wired several hundred dollars for brining in the contraband. Id. During the investigation, a conversation between Mr. Jackson and his sister was captured, in which they were heard talking about how the staff person had who was involved in brining in the contraband had picked up money from them and that they were upset about a deal that had not been completed. Id. They were also heard discussing how Mr. Jackson's sister had

received money from other offenders, adding up to hundreds of dollars.

Id.

On December 7, 2007, in preparation for the infraction hearing, Mr. Jackson received a Hearing Notice/Appearance Waiver form that informed him of the charge against him, the upcoming hearing, and his procedural rights. Exhibit 2, Attachment C, Hearing Notice/Appearance Waiver. Mr. Jackson did not request any witness statements. Id. Prior to the hearing, Mr. Jackson sent a kite to the hearings officer requesting a copy of the phone recording that was noted in the infraction notice. Exhibit 2, Attachment D, 12-7-07 Kite and 12-9-07 Letter. The MICC Chief Investigator wrote to Mr. Jackson, informing him that his request for the recording was denied pursuant RCW 9.73.095(3)(b).⁴ Exhibit 2, Attachment E, December 19, 2007 letter.

Mr. Jackson's hearing took place on December 12, 2007. Exhibit 2, Attachment F, Disciplinary Hearing Minutes and Findings; PRP, Exhibit 6. Mr. Jackson pled not guilty to the 606 infraction. Id. At the hearing, Mr. Jackson provided an oral and written statement. Id.; Exhibit 2, Attachment G, Statement. After Mr. Jackson's statement and reviewing

all evidence, the Hearing Officer found Mr. Jackson guilty of the 606 infractions. Exhibit 2, Attachment H, Serious Infraction Report; Attachment I, Pictures of contraband. The Hearing Officer based his decision on the infraction report, that included the statement by the investigator that he recognized Mr. Jackson's voice on the telephone calls where he discussed the staff person picking up money and then not completing the deal. Exhibit 2, Attachment H. The Hearing Officer sanctioned Mr. Jackson with a loss of 5 days good conduct time and 10 days in segregation. Id.

After the hearing, Mr. Jackson wrote multiple letters and appealed the disciplinary hearing decision fining him guilty of the 606 infraction. Exhibit 2, Attachment I, Letters and Kites from Mr. Jackson.⁵ The Superintendent's designee denied the appeal. Exhibit 2, Attachment J, Disciplinary Hearing Appeal Decision.

Mr. Jackson is challenging the disciplinary hearing decision, claiming that he was denied due process at his hearing and that there was no evidence to support the guilty finding. See PRP. The Department opposes Mr. Jackson's Petition and asks that it be dismissed.

III. STATEMENT OF ISSUES

A. Whether Mr. Jackson was afforded all requisite due process of law at his prison disciplinary hearing?

B. Whether the Hearings Officer's finding of guilt is supported by some or any evidence in the record?

IV. STANDARD OF REVIEW

The court may not grant relief from a PRP unless the inmate is able to prove either that he suffered actual and substantial prejudice as a result of constitutional error or that non-constitutional error resulted in a complete miscarriage of justice. In re Krier, 108 Wn. App. 31, 37-38, 29 P.3d 720 (2001) (citing In re Cook, 114 Wn.2d 802, 813, 792 P.2d 506 [1990]; In re Reismiller, 101 Wn.2d 291, 293, 678 P.2d 323 [1984]); In re Gronquist, 138 Wn.2d 388, 396, 978 P.2d 1083 (1999), cert. denied, 528 U.S. 1009 (1999). The inmate has the burden of proving by a preponderance of the evidence that he was actually and substantially prejudiced by constitutional error. Cook, 114 Wn.2d at 814 (citing In re Hews, 99 Wn.2d 80, 89, 660 P.2d 263 [1983]). If the inmate fails to meet the burden of proving actual and substantial prejudice, the court should necessarily refuse to reach the merits of the petition. Cook, 114 Wn.2d at 810.

The petitioner must not only be presently restrained, that restraint must be due to a constitutional error. In re Myers, 91 Wn.2d 120, 122, 587 P.2d 532 (1978), overruled on other grounds by Hews v. Evans, 99 Wn.2d 80; RAP 16.4. To determine whether the petitioner has been actually prejudiced by the claimed error, the merits of the petitioner's constitutional claim must first be examined. Conclusory allegations of constitutional violations are insufficient to support a PRP. In re Cook, 114 Wn.2d at 813. The petitioner must present evidence that is more than speculation, conjecture, or inadmissible hearsay to support his contentions. Gronquist, 138 Wn.2d at 395; In re Rice, 118 Wn.2d 876, 886, 828 P.2d 1086, cert. denied, 506 U.S. 958 (1992).

V. ARGUMENT

A. **MR. JACKSON WAS AFFORDED ALL REQUISITE DUE PROCESS OF LAW AT HIS PRISON DISCIPLINARY HEARING.**

In the review of prison disciplinary proceedings, the court is limited to determining whether the action taken was "so arbitrary and capricious as to deny the petitioner a fundamentally fair hearing." Reismiller, 101 Wn.2d at 294. An inmate facing a disciplinary hearing that may result in a loss of liberty, unlike the accused facing criminal charges, is entitled only to minimal due process protection. In re Plunkett, 57 Wn. App. 230, 235, 788 P.2d 1090 (1990). Prison inmates facing disciplinary

proceedings where state created liberty interests are at issue do not enjoy the full panoply of due process safeguards. Wolff v. McDonnell, 418 U.S. 539, 94 S. Ct. 2963 (1974). However, these inmates are entitled to: (1) written notice of the charges against them at least 24 hours in advance of the hearing; (2) an opportunity to call witnesses and present documentary evidence in their defense, provided that doing so will not be unduly hazardous to institutional safety or correctional goals; and (3) a written statement of the evidence relied upon and the reasons for the Hearing Officer's findings. Wolff, 418 U.S. at 563-66; Gronquist, 138 Wn.2d at 396-97; Krier, 108 Wn. App. at 38.

In the instant case, all requirements for due process were met at Mr. Jackson's disciplinary hearing on December 12, 2007. First, Mr. Jackson received notice of the charges against him five days before his hearing was held. Exhibit 2, Attachments B, C, F & H. At the hearing, despite Mr. Jackson's claims that not having a copy of the phone call prevented him from presenting a defense, Mr. Jackson presented a lengthy statement in his own defense at the hearing. Exhibit 2, Attachments F & G; PRP, Exhibit 6. Upon the conclusion of the hearing, Mr. Jackson was provided with a written statement setting forth the guilty finding, the evidence relied on and the reason for the guilty finding. Exhibit 2,

Attachments F & H. Therefore, Mr. Jackson received all the due process required at his December 12, 2007 hearing.

Despite receiving all the due process required under Wolff, Mr. Jackson claims that his due process rights were violated because (1) he was not allowed to hear the phone conversation that was referenced in the infraction; (2) that confidential information was not treated properly, and (3) that he was not provided an adequate summary of the evidence relied upon. See PRP, pp 17 - 25 , & 30 - 32. As there is no support for these claims, Mr. Jackson's PRP should be dismissed.

First, Mr. Jackson claims that because he was not allowed to listen to the phone call reference in the infraction he was not able to prepare a defense. PRP at 17 - 19. This claim fails for two reasons. First, the Department under RCW 9.73.095(3)(b) was prohibited from giving Mr. Jackson a copy of the telephone recording. Second, Mr. Jackson was given the information contained in the telephone recording, and prepared a lengthy defense, including his version of what was meant by what was said during the conversation. Exhibit 2, Attachments B & G; PRP, Exhibit 6. Although Mr. Jackson was provided only a summary of the telephone conversation, Mr. Jackson was able to respond to the claims against him and provided his version of what occurred during the phone call Exhibit 2, Attachments B, F, & G; PRP, Exhibit 6. Mr. Jackson was able to

prepare a defense to the evidence presented, Mr. Jackson's claim that he was not able to present a defense fails.

Next, Mr. Jackson claims that the hearing officer failed to make an independent determination of the reliability of the confidential information. PRP, pp. 19 – 25. As there is no indication that confidential information was used in finding Mr. Jackson guilty, it was not necessary for the hearing officer to make a determination regarding confidential information. Exhibit 2, Attachments F & H. The evidence used to find Mr. Jackson guilty of the infraction was the information contained in the initial infraction report, which consisted of a summary of the telephone conversation between Mr. Jackson and his sister, as well as the statement by investigator Baxter that he recognized Mr. Jackson's as being one of the speakers during the telephone call.

Last, Mr. Jackson claims that he was not provided an adequate summary of the evidence used to find him guilty. PRP, pp. 30 – 31. This argument fails, in that the hearing officer clearly indicated in the Hearing Minutes and the Serious Infraction Notice what evidence he relied upon in finding Mr. Jackson guilty. Exhibit 2, Attachments F & H. Specifically, the hearing officer used the written statement by Investigator Baxter that he heard a conversation between offender Jackson and the offender's sister that implicated Mr. Jackson in the contraband scheme. Id. As reflected by

Mr. Jackson's multiple letters and kites after the hearing setting forth his basis for appeal, Mr. Jackson received enough information regarding the basis for the guilty finding. Exhibit 2, Attachment J. As Mr. Jackson received adequate notice of the basis of his guilty finding, Mr. Jackson received all requisite due process of law at his disciplinary hearing and his Petition should be dismissed.

B. MR. JACKSON'S INFRACTION WAS SUPPORTED BY SOME EVIDENCE.

Mr. Jackson's infraction was supported by some evidence in accordance with due process requirements. Prison disciplinary decisions must be upheld by reviewing courts if supported by "some" or "any" evidence. Superintendent v. Hill, 472 U.S. 445, 105 S. Ct. 2768, 86 L. Ed. 2d 256 (1985); In re Reismiller, 101 Wn.2d 291, 678 P.2d 323 (1984). Ascertaining whether the "any" evidence test is satisfied does not require examination of the entire record, independent assessment of the credibility of witnesses, or weighing of the evidence. Superintendent v. Hill, 472 U.S. at 455.

Mr. Jackson was charged with and found guilty of violating WAC 137-28-260 (606), "Possession, introduction or transfer of any tobacco, tobacco products, matches, or tobacco paraphernalia." Exhibit 2, Attachment B & H. This finding was supported by some evidence. The

hearing officer clearly states in the Serious Infraction Report what evidence he relied upon to render a guilty finding –the information received and summarized by Investigator Baxter. Exhibit 2, Attachment

H. Specifically the evidence used was the following statement:

During the course of a HQ Special Investigation Unit (SIU) Investigation of staff misconduct at MICC, information was received and evidence was recovered that the staff member under investigation was introducing contraband into MICC. This staff member turned over one cardboard box of contraband to the SIU unit that contained eight (8) large Top tobacco boxes, 10 (10) cans of Grizzly chew tobacco, one (1) large Tin of Top tobacco, five bags of plastic wrap tobacco and five packages of rolling paper. This staff member stated that she had been wired several hundred dollars for contraband she was to introduce to MICC. I, knowing offender Jackson's voice overheard Jackson and his sister ex-DOC offender Shelia Hanley #951670 talking about how this staff had picked up the money and were mad that the deal had not been completed by the staff. Offender Jackson and Ms. Hanley were also overheard talking about other money sent to Ms. Hanley by at least 6 other offenders at MICC adding up to hundreds of dollars.

Exhibit 2, Attachment B.

This evidence certainly satisfies the "some" evidence test and supports finding Mr. Jackson guilty of the infraction. Rudd v. Sargent, 866 F.2d 260, 262 (8th Cir. 1989). While Mr. Jackson explains his version of the events, apparently the hearing officer and the Superintendent's designee both found Investigator Baxter's version of the events more credible. Exhibit 2, Attachments G & J. Mr. Jackson's


statement that the officer that was found bringing in the contraband had cashed a \$300 money order from Mr. Jackson's sister, combined with the summary of the telephone conversation between Mr. Jackson and his sister provided by Investigator Baxter, was certainly some evidence in which the Hearing Officer could base a guilty finding. See PRP, Exhibit 6; Exhibit 2, Attachment B. As there was some evidence upon which the guilty finding was based, Mr. Jackson's PRP should be dismissed.

VI. CONCLUSION

For the above stated reasons, the Department respectfully requests this Court deny and dismiss Mr. Jackson's PRP.



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
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Attachment A is a true and correct copy of the Legal Face Sheet screen for Vernon Jackson, DOC #283484, which I obtained from the OMNI.

On 1/08/08 an appeal of this hearing was received from you in which you requested review of the hearing officer's decision and /or sanction. DECISION AND SANCTION

You appealed:

- The finding(s) of guilt
- The sanction(s) imposed

In summary, your appeal states:

AN ASSOCIATE OF MINE TOLD ME THAT HE KNEW SOMEONE WHO COULD GET MY WEB SITE PAGES DONE FOR ME. LATE SEPTEMBER I WAS INTRODUCED TO THIS INMATE, HE STATED THAT HE WOULD NOT CHARGE ME REALLY BEING IN PRISON KNOWING ONE DOES NOT HAVE MONEY. HE ASKED ME WHAT I COULD AFFORD AND HE SAID HE WOULD CHARGE ME \$300.00 AND ASKED IF I COULD SEND THE MONEY. HE STATED THAT ONCE THE MONEY WAS THERE, HIS FAMILY WOULD GET ON IT AND I WOULD GET COPIES OF WORK DONE EVERY 72 HRS IN THE MAIL HERE. HE GAVE ME A P.O. BOX NUMBER AND STATED TO LEAVE THE MONEY ORDER BLANK. I HAD MY SISTER GET THE MONEY, EVEN THOUGH SHE DID NOT WANT TO SEND A MONEY ORDER WITHOUT A NAME ON IT. THE GUY SAID MY MONEY HAD NOT GOTTEN THERE BUT MY PAPERWORK DID. I HAD MY SISTER RUN A TRACE ON THAT MONEY TO SEE IF IT WAS CASHED OR NOT. WHERE IN ANY TESTIMONY OR SUPPLEMENTAL STAFF STATEMENT DOES IT STATE ANY OF THAT PRODUCT DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY INVOLVES ME. AS IT BEING PAID FOR BY ME, OR THAT ANY OF THAT PRODUCT WAS TO COME TO ME OR THAT SHE RECEIVED ANY WIRE FROM ME OR MY SISTER FOR POSSESSION OR INTRODUCTION OR TRANSFER OF ANY TOBACCO WHAT SO EVER. I'D LIKE TO SEE THESE WIRE TRANSFER RECORDS.

In reviewing your appeal, I have made the following determination(s):

- The disciplinary hearing process was conducted in accordance with Due Process and WAC 137-28.
- At least 24 hours advance written notice was provided or you waived the 24 hour advance notice in writing/with witness.
- You were provided an opportunity to call witnesses and present documentary evidence on your behalf. If witness(es) were denied, the Hearing Officer provided you with written reason(s) for the denial.
- The finding was made by an impartial (not viewed as biased or having witnessed the incident being heard) Hearing Officer.
- A written statement of the finding(s) and sanction(s) imposed was provided to you and includes the evidence relied on and the reason(s) for the decision.
- Sanction(s) are in accordance with Presumptive Sanction Guidelines WAC 137-28.

If confidential information was submitted, I have confirmed:

- The Hearing Officer made an independent determination regarding reliability of the confidential source(s), credibility of the information and, safety concerns that justify non-disclosure of the confidential source(s) of information.
- The above information was documented on DOC form 21-962, Confidential Information Review Checklist.

On behalf of the Superintendent, I have investigated your appeal and find that:

DOCUMENTS REPORT THAT DURING THE COURSE OF A HQ SPECIAL INVESTIGATION OF STAFF MISCONDUCT, INFORMATION WAS RECEIVED AND EVIDENCE RECOVERED THAT THE STAFF MEMBER UNDER INVESTIGATION WAS INTRODUCING CONTRABAND INTO MICC. THIS STAFF MEMBER STATED THAT SHE HAD BEEN WIRED SEVERAL HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR CONTRABAND SHE WAS TO INTRODUCE TO MICC. YOU WERE OVERHEARD TALKING TO YOUR SISTER SHEILA HENLY ABOUT HOW THIS STAFF HAD PICKED UP THE MONEY AND WERE TOLD THAT THE DEAL HAD NOT BEEN COMPLETED BY THE STAFF. YOU AND MS. HENLY WERE ALSO OVERHEARD TALKING ABOUT OTHER MONEY SENT TO MS. HENLY BY AT LEAST 6 OTHER OFFENDERS ADDING UP TO HUNDREDS OF DOLLARS. I HAVE REVIEWED YOUR APPEAL AND FIND THAT THE SANCTIONS ARE IN ACCORDANCE WITH WAC 606: POSSESSION, INTRODUCTION OR TRANSFER OF TOBACCO, TOBACCO PRODUCTS, MATCHES, OR TOBACCO PARAPHERNALIA. YOU HAVE PROVIDED NO NEW EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS THAT WOULD CAUSE A CHANGE IN THE FINDINGS OF GUILT. I CONCUR WITH THE DECISION AND SANCTION(S) OF THE HEARINGS OFFICER.

- You were found guilty as explained above;
- There was insufficient evidence for a finding of guilt as explained below;
