Pursuant to RAP 10.8, The State respectfully cites the following as additional authority:

*State v. Smith*, 162 Wn. App. 833, 846-48, 262 P.3d 72 (2011) review denied, 173 Wn.2d 1007, 271 P.3d 248 (2012).

In response to the State's question at the beginning of voir dire, the trial court explained its normal procedures for sealing juror questionnaires: (1) Only counsel and the trial court would view the questionnaires; (2) the questionnaires would not be available to the general public; and (3) the court clerk would seal the questionnaires after voir dire. Jackson agreed to the language in the juror questionnaires that explained these procedures and expressly affirmed that he was satisfied with these procedures. Thereafter, Jackson actively participated in voir dire, using the questionnaires to his
