



Pursuant to RAP 10.8, Washington State Association for Justice Foundation submits the following corrected additional authorities regarding prospective application of the medical negligence statute of limitations (see WSAJ Fdn. Am. Br., at 18-19):

1. Ueland v. Reynolds Metals Co., 103 Wn.2d 131, 140-41, 691 P.2d 190 (1984) (recognizing claim for loss of parental consortium, and “limit[ing] this new right of action to causes of action arising on or after the date of the filing of the opinion, except that it is to be applicable in the present case”); and

2. Erdman v. B.P.O.E., 41 Wn. App. 197, 211-212, 704 P.2d 150 (1985) (rejecting claim for loss of parental consortium arising before Ueland given the “mandate of Ueland”, and suggesting that, unless the appellate court specifically provides that the prospective ruling applies to the case before it or similarly situated pending cases, such cases will not be entitled to the benefit of the “prospective” holding).
