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**ANSWER TO MOTION FOR DISCRETIONARY REVIEW**

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## I. INTRODUCTION

Respondent, the Washington Department of Corrections (Department or DOC) provides this briefing in response to this Court's November 17, 2017 Ruling requesting clarification on several issues. The Court directed the Department to include evidence or argument on the following: 1) whether *State v. Acrey*, 97 Wn. App. 784, 988 P.2d 17 (1999), controls; 2) a clear and precise calculation of start dates and "release" dates for each of Gronquist's three sentences; 3) dates for related terms of community custody; 4) the Department's basis for Gronquist's continued custody despite the fact that he has apparently reached his earned release date; and 5) an explanation for the Department's change in his release date calculation from 2016.

## II. BASIS FOR CUSTODY

Gronquist is serving an exceptional sentence for three counts of sexually motivated attempted first degree kidnapping, committed in December 1993. Appendix A, Judgment and Sentence, *State v. Gronquist*, King County Superior Court Cause No. 93-1-00121-1 at 1. He is in state custody at the Monroe Correctional Complex in Monroe, Washington. Appendix B, Legal Face Sheet, at 1 (showing location as MCC). The trial court (the Honorable George Mattson) sentenced him to three consecutive terms of 114-months for a total of 342 months of confinement and two years

of community placement. Appendix A, at 3 and at “Appendix H” (Appendix H to the Judgment and Sentence, there is no page number); Appendix C, Order Amending Judgment and Sentence, *State v. Gronquist*, King County Superior Court Cause No. 93-1-00121-1. His early release date was June 14, 2013. Appendix B, at 1 (showing “ERD: 06/14/2013”). His prison term maximum expiration date is May 31, 2022. *Id.* at 1 (showing “Prison Max Expiration Date”).

### III. STATEMENT OF THE CASE

#### A. Good Conduct Time Versus Maximum Expiration Date

Good conduct time has no effect on a maximum expiration date. It affects only the early release date because good time is early release time. The maximum expiration date is the date that an offender will release if he serves the sentence imposed by the trial court without any reduction for early release. The word “maximum” is defined by Merriam-Webster online dictionary as “the greatest quantity or value attainable or attained.”<sup>1</sup> Good conduct time is part of the early release date calculation, not the prison term maximum expiration date calculation. Good conduct time is a percentage of time by which an offender may earn reductions in his/her sentence by participating in prison programs and complying with prison rules.

The sentencing court imposed 114 months of confinement for each count. Appendix A. Gronquist's maximum sentence expiration (the time he is required to serve in confinement assuming he earns no good conduct time reductions), therefore, is 114 months for each count.

**B. Maximum Expiration Date Calculation Method and Analysis, and Explanation for Changes**

The maximum expiration date is the total confinement term set by the court. To determine the maximum expiration date, the confinement term ordered by the court, less any presentence time *served*, is added to the date of the sentence. Unlike the determination of Gronquist's earned early release date, good conduct time does not apply to Gronquist's maximum expiration date because good time credits are not days he actually served.

**1. Maximum Sentence Expiration Calculation**

Gronquist's maximum expiration (Max Ex) date is calculated as follows:

Broken down by count, the Department credited Gronquist's first 3,469 day sentence with a total of 453 presentence credits. Appendix D, OMNI View J&S - Prison. Subtracting 453 days from 3,469 leaves 3,016 days to serve on Gronquist's first count per the judgment and sentence. Adding 3,016 days to Gronquist's start date of February 28, 1995 results in a maximum expiration date of June 2, 2003. This is the maximum date

Gronquist could be required to serve in prison on the first 114-month (3,469 day) sentence. This date, June 2, 2003, is the date Gronquist would be released but for his consecutive counts. Gronquist's second maximum expiration date is calculated from the maximum expiration date of his first confinement term. Adding 3,469 days to June 2, 2003 results in a maximum expiration date of November 30, 2012. The maximum expiration date for count three is calculated by adding 3,469 days to the maximum expiration date from count two. This results in a maximum expiration date on count three of May 31, 2022.

Therefore, if Gronquist continues to be unable to provide an approved release plan, he actually release on May 31, 2022.

## **2. Explanation of Prior Calculations**

Offenders such as Gronquist are not entitled to earned early release. “[O]ffenders . . . , who are subject to statutory community custody or placement restrictions, are ‘excluded’ from the program allowing general release based on earned early release credits.” *In re the Personal Restraint of Crowder*, 97 Wn. App. 598, 600, 985 P.2d 944 (1999). “Instead of general release, the Legislature specified that community placement offenders may only become eligible for transfer to community custody status.” *Id.* “An inmate not approved for community custody must remain in prison until his maximum release date, and begin the sentence of

community placement at that time.” *In re the Personal Restraint of Capello*, 106 Wn. App. 576, 579, 24 P.3d 1074, 1076 (2001) *superseded by statute as stated in In re Stewart*, 115 Wn. App. 319, 75 P.3d 521 (2003).

The Department originally *hand* calculated his Max Ex at July 18, 2022. Appendix E, Original Legal Face Sheet; *see also* Appendix F, Declaration of Wendy Stigall at ¶ 5. Gronquist prevailed on a personal restraint petition in 1999, which entitled him to be eligible for additional good conduct time and resulted in new sentence calculations. *See In re Smith*, 139 Wn.2d 199, 986 P.2d 131 (1999); *see also* Appendix F at ¶ 6.

The Department’s subsequent *electronic* calculations modified Gronquist’s ERD to August 9, 2013 and his Max Ex to October 8, 2016. Appendix G, 1999 Release Date Calculation Sheet. The Department later recalculated his ERD to September 18, 2013 and his Max Ex to November 17, 2016. Appendix H, 2008 Release Date Calculation Sheets, at 3. However, these dates were incorrect because the program failed to account for the total 342 months to which Gronquist was sentenced. Appendix F at ¶ 6-7.

The Department incorporated “stoppage time” into its electronic calculations after the Offender Management Network Information (OMNI) program was implemented in August of 2008. *Id.* at ¶ 8. Gronquist’s July 30, 2008 calculation, therefore, failed to include stoppage time. “Stoppage

time” is the time during which the prison maximum expiration date (Max Ex) or statutory maximum (Stat Max) clock stops while an offender is serving time on another count/cause. *Id.* Stoppage time can be applied during confinement time, enhancement time, or periods of community custody. *Id.* Max Ex calculations will contain stoppage time in consecutive relationships. *Id.*

The Department later correctly recalculated Gronquist’s maximum sentence expiration date by applying stoppage time. This moved his Max Ex date back to May 31, 2022, as originally calculated in 1995. *Id.* at ¶ 9.

### **3. Earned Early Release Date (ERD) Calculations**

Earned release credits determine the date he may be released *early* from his sentence. Because good time credits can fluctuate, ERDs remain fluid until an offender actually releases *from custody*. In this case, Gronquist was not released from confinement but was released Cause AB to Cause AC on Cause AB’s early release date. Appendix D. Restoration of good time credits does not change the maximum expiration date, which is the sentence ordered by the Court. Good time credits only change the earned release date, not the maximum expiration date, which is at issue in this Petition.

As of December 20, 2017, Gronquist’s earned early release dates for each cause were September 4, 2000, March 6, 2007, and July 9, 2013,

respectively. Appendix D. Thus, if Gronquist had met his release requirements, he would have released on July 9, 2013.

Gronquist's earned early release dates are calculated<sup>2</sup> as follows:

For Cause AB, Gronquist received a 114-month (3,469 days) sentence. Appendix D. The total 3,469 minus 679 days of credits (jail good conduct time plus earned time actually earned) equals 2,790 days remaining to serve. Taking 33.33% from 2,790 results in a potential minimum sentence of 1,860 days. As of December 20, 2017, Gronquist had lost or failed to earn 155 days. Adding 155 days back to Gronquist's minimum potential sentence of 1,860 results in 2,015 days total Gronquist had to serve. Adding 2,015 to Gronquist's start date of February 28, 1995 results in an earned early release date of September 4, 2000. *Id.*

For Cause AC, Gronquist received the same 3,469-day sentence. *Id.* Sixty-six percent of 3,469 equals a potential minimum confinement term of 2,312 days. Gronquist has failed to earn 61.25 days, which must be added back to 2,312 for a total of 2,373 days. Adding 2,373 days to his time start date of September 4, 2000 results in an earned early release date of March 5, 2007. *Id.*

For Cause AD, Gronquist again received a 3,469-day sentence. *Id.* Sixty-six percent of 3,469 equals a potential minimum confinement term of 2,312 days. Gronquist has failed to earn 4.33 days, which added back to 2,312 equals 2,316. Adding 2,316 days to Gronquist's time start date of March 6, 2007 results in an earned early release date of July 8, 2013. *Id.*

Gronquist failed to release on his ERD due to his failure to meet the requirements for early release.

**C. Basis for Continued Custody**

Gronquist was sentenced to a term of community placement. Appendix A, at 3 & Appendix H (to Judgment and Sentence). At the time Gronquist was sentenced, RCW 9.94A.205(1) stated:

If an inmate violates any condition or requirement of community custody, *the department may transfer the inmate to a more restrictive confinement status to serve up to the remaining portion of the sentence, less credit for any period actually spent in community custody or in detention awaiting disposition of an alleged violation . . . .*

RCW 9.94A.205(1) (1995) (emphasis added).

Gronquist began serving his second confinement term on August 10, 2000, before the expiration of the maximum sentence date of June 2, 2003. Appendix D, (Cause AC – Time Start Date “08/10/2000”). The same is true for Gronquist's third confinement term. Gronquist released to his third count on February 4, 2007, prior to the maximum expiration date of

November 30, 2012. Appendix D, (Cause AD – Time Start Date “02/04/2007”).

However, the period between Gronquist’s earned released date on Causes AB and AC and his maximum expiration date on each count remain part of his original sentence, and he was allowed early release only provisionally: if he violated the terms of his sentence, the DOC could return him to his original prison term. Former RCW 9.94A.205(1) (1995), currently codified as RCW 9.94A.633(2)(a). To date, the DOC has not released Gronquist because he has not provided a viable release address.

To date, Gronquist remains incarcerated past his *earned early release* date due to the lack of a viable release address. Appendix I, *In re Gronquist*, Court of Appeals Cause No. 70333-1-I; Appendix J, OMNI Chrono; Appendix K, Offender Release Plan, at 3 (Counselor Outside Origin Comments). Gronquist will remain confined until May 21, 2022, the maximum expiration date, after completing the entire 342 month sentence ordered by the Superior Court, if he is unable to obtain an approved release address.

#### **D. Community Custody Release**

The Department is unable to provide definitive “release” dates for Gronquist’s community custody term at this time. Appendix F at ¶ 10. Community custody end dates fluctuate significantly based upon the

offender's compliance with community custody conditions, periods of unrelated confinement or absence from supervision, etc. *Id.* Furthermore, should Gronquist acquire an approved release plan prior to his Max Ex date, he would be eligible for early release in lieu of prison and further affect his scheduled end date. *Id.*

#### IV. ISSUES

1. Whether Gronquist's ongoing detention is lawful.
2. Whether the Department is correctly calculating Gronquist's maximum expiration date.
3. Whether *State v. Acrey*, 97 Wn. App. 784 (1999) applies.

#### V. ARGUMENT

##### A. **The DOC Properly Refused To Release Gronquist Early Because He Has Not Obtained An Approved Release Address**

The statute requiring certain inmates to obtain approval of release addresses prior to early release to community custody does not establish a due process liberty interest in release. *In re Mattson*, 166 Wn.2d 730, 740, ¶ 17, 214 P.3d 141 (2009) (interpreting former RCW 9.94A.728(2)<sup>3</sup>). Rather, the statute grants offenders only the right to have DOC follow its own legitimately established procedures regarding early release into community custody. *Id.*; *see also In re Crowder*, 97 Wn. App. 598, 601, 985 P.2d 944 (1999) (finding

no liberty interest in parole release decisions under RCW 9.95.100 because of the discretionary nature of decision and statute's presumption of continued incarceration).

If the DOC were to release Gronquist to community custody prior to his obtaining an approved release address, it would violate his sentence, statute, and the DOC's rules. *In re Crowder*, 97 Wn. App. at 601.

**B. The Department is Correctly Calculating Gronquist's Maximum Sentence Expiration Based on Three Consecutive 114-Month Sentences**

Gronquist argues that when the Department recalculated his earned release time following this Court's decision in *In re Smith & Gronquist*, 139 Wn.2d 199, 986 P.2d 131 (1992), these recalculations should have resulted in a new maximum expiration date. But Gronquist confuses his earned release date with his maximum expiration date. The percentage by which Gronquist earns release credits has no effect on his maximum expiration date. This is because the maximum expiration date is the sentence imposed, without earned early release credits.

In the case of consecutive sentences, "*all periods of total confinement shall be served*" before any partial confinement, community supervision or other conditions of any sentence. *See* RCW 9.94A.589(5)<sup>4</sup>

(emphasis added); *see also State v. Israel*, 113 Wn. App. 243, 54 P.3d 1218 (2002) (First-degree kidnapping is a serious violent offense within the meaning of the statute requiring consecutive sentences for serious violent offenses.).

Thus, should Gronquist serve the maximum sentence ordered by the Court, he will serve three consecutive 114-month sentences (or 10,407 days). The Department credited Gronquist's first Cause AB with 453 days, leaving 9,954 days. Appendix D. The Department's calculation of Gronquist's maximum expiration date of May 31, 2022<sup>5</sup> is 9,954 days from his start date of February 28, 1995. Appendix D.

The Department's calculation of Gronquist's maximum expiration date is correct. The Court should dismiss the petition.

**C. Because The Max Ex Clock Tolls, Preserving Earned Early Release Time, When The Offender Serves Confinement Time Attributable Solely To Another Cause, *Acrey*, 97 Wn. App. 784 (1999), Applies To This Case<sup>6</sup>**

RCW 9.94A.707 provides that "Community custody shall begin: (a) upon completion of the term of confinement; or (b) at the time of sentencing if no term of confinement is ordered." Under this statute, an offender cannot serve community custody until he actually is released from total

confinement. For an offender eligible for community custody in lieu of earned early release under RCW 9.94A.729(5), his community custody cannot begin until he is released to the community. If, however, the offender owes confinement time on a consecutive sentence, he is not released from confinement on the ERD of the first sentence, but rather is transferred to begin serving confinement on the second sentence. Because he is not actually released from confinement, his community custody in lieu of early release would not begin, but rather would toll pending completion of the consecutive confinement term.

RCW 9.94A.171(3) supports this conclusion. The statute provides, with certain exceptions not relevant here, that the term of community custody shall be tolled during any period of time the offender is in confinement for any reason. Thus, the term of community custody owed in lieu of earned early release on the parent cause should toll while the offender is in total confinement on the child cause. The community custody time will toll until the offender is released from total confinement on all the consecutive sentences.

RCW 9.94A.589(5) similarly supports this conclusion. In pertinent part, that statute provides that “[i]n the case of consecutive sentences, all periods of total confinement shall be served before any partial confinement, community restitution, community supervision, or any other requirement or

conditions of any of the sentences.” This statute requires the offender to serve the confinement sentence on the child cause before the offender serves the community custody portion of the parent cause. Thus, when the offender is released on the ERD of the parent cause to begin serving the child cause, the community custody portion of the parent cause will be postponed until the offender serves the confinement on the child cause. The offender will then serve the community custody on the parent cause after release from confinement on any child causes. If the community custody portion of the parent cause were not tolled while the offender served his confinement on the child cause, the offender would effectively serve part of his consecutive sentence concurrently, contravening RCW 9.94A.589(5) and his judgment and sentence.

Washington case law also supports the conclusion that the remaining time on the parent cause tolls while the offender is serving the consecutive child cause sentence, and the offender must serve that time on community custody in lieu of earned early release for the parent cause upon completion of the sentence of total confinement for the child cause. In *State v. Acrey*, 97 Wn. App. 784 (1999) and *State v. Cameron*, 71 Wn. App. 653, 861 P.2d 1069 (1993), the Court of Appeals considered situations where the offender had two concurrent sentences, with one shorter sentence containing a term of supervision, and one longer sentence without a term of

supervision. Under the statutes, the offender first served the two terms of confinement imposed for the two counts, followed by the term of supervision. In both cases, the court held the term of supervision tolled while the offender finished serving the longer confinement term on the second count. *Acrey*, 97 Wn. App. at 787-88; *Cameron*, 71 Wn. App. at 656-57.

The same reasoning applies in the case of consecutive sentences. The offender must serve the sentences of confinement first, and the community custody tolls while the offender is in confinement. Because the offender would have been on community custody in lieu of earned early release as of the ERD, this time tolls and the offender must serve this time after completing the sentence of confinement on the consecutive child cause.

The Washington Supreme Court's ruling in *State v. Jones*, 172 Wn.2d 236, 257 P.3d 616 (2011), supports this conclusion as well. In *Jones*, the Court held that an offender was not entitled to credit against the term of community custody for excess time he was held in confinement after his sentence was amended. In that case, the offender was originally sentenced to 130 months confinement, followed by 36 months community custody. *Id.* at 239. The sentence was later held invalid, and was amended to 51 months confinement, and 36 months community custody. *Id.* By the time the

sentence was amended, the offender had already served 81 months in confinement. *Id.* The offender contended the excess time in confinement should be applied to his term of community custody. *Id.* at 239-40.

Applying the prior version of the tolling statute, the Court held that the community custody tolled as a result of confinement, even erroneous confinement, and the offender was not entitled to credit his erroneous confinement time against his community custody time. *Id.* at 242-49. Even though the tolling statute has been amended, the result is the same under the current statute. The term of community custody tolls while the offender is confined. The offender's confinement on the second consecutive sentence tolls the community custody portion of the parent cause.

Gronquist argues that the time on the two earlier causes should continue to run despite his transfer to the final cause under the rule that a sentence continues to run until it expires, notwithstanding parole. *See Paschke*, 61 Wn. App. 591, 595, 811 P.2d 694, 696 (1991) (citing *January v. Porter*, 75 Wn.2d 768, 776-77, 453 P.2d 876 (1969); *State v. Jennings*, 45 Wn. App. 858, 860, 728 P.2d 1064 (1986)). But this rule applies to pre-SRA indeterminate sentences, not SRA determinate sentences, because of a unique distinction between parole and community custody. The courts recognize that parole is part of the sentence of confinement imposed by the superior court – parole is simply an act of grace that allows the offender to

serve that sentence of confinement in the community rather than in prison. *January v. Porter*, 75 Wn.2d at 774. Because the offender is serving the same sentence, the sentence continues to run even though the offender is on parole.

In contrast, community custody and confinement are distinct sentence elements. *See State v. Jones*, 172 Wn.2d at 244-45 (recognizing statutory difference between term of confinement and term of community custody, and holding the offender is not entitled to credit time in confinement against community custody); *also, compare* RCW 9.94A.030(8) (defining confinement to mean partial or total confinement) *with* RCW 9.94A.030(5) (defining community custody to mean time “served in the community subject to controls placed on the offender’s movement and activities by the department.”). Community custody, whether imposed by the court or served in lieu of early release, cannot run while the offender remains confined. RCW 9.94A.707. The community custody on a parent cause, therefore, tolls and is served once the offender has finished the sentence of confinement on the child cause.

Gronquist’s Max Ex date is correctly calculated because he must still complete the terms of community custody for each sentence after he is released from total confinement. Because his community custody is in lieu of confinement, it must still be included in the Max Ex calculation.

## VI. CONCLUSION

Because the Department correctly calculated Gronquist's Max Ex date, Respondent respectfully requests that this court deny Gronquist's petition.





5. When Derek Gronquist was originally admitted to the Department's custody for his sentences in these cases, the Department calculated release dates and maximum sentence expiration dates by hand. Thus, his original legal face sheet (Appendix E) represents a hand calculation. In it, Gronquist's maximum sentence expiration date ran his three 114-month sentences consecutive to each other for a maximum expiration date of July 18, 2022.

6. Gronquist's earned early release date changed after he prevailed on an appeal in 1999, which entitled him to be eligible for 33% good conduct time reductions, as opposed to 15% good conduct time reductions. At that time, the Department used a computer system to perform sentence calculations. The computer system failed to account for stoppage time. Therefore the Max Ex dates that it applied were incorrect.

7. "Stoppage time" is the time during which the prison maximum expiration date (Max Ex) or statutory maximum (Stat Max) clock stops while an offender is serving time on another count/cause. Stoppage time can be applied during confinement time, enhancement time, or periods

of community custody. Max Ex calculations will contain stoppage time in consecutive relationships.

8. The Department updated stoppage time calculations in the OMNI system in December, 2016.

9. With the calculation correction implemented through OMNI, Gronquist's Max Ex date changed a final time to May 31, 2022.

10. The Department is unable to provide definitive "release" dates for Gronquist's community custody at this time. The end date will depend on several variables including: his release date from prison, his compliance with conditions while he is in the community, any periods for which he is on abscond status or has new criminal activity, etc.

11. Gronquist remains in custody for failure to provide an approved release plan.

Derek Gronquist filed a petition for a writ of mandamus to compel the Department of Corrections (DOC) to process his offender release plan according to DOC policy. Gronquist paid a filing fee and the King County Superior Court opened Cause No. 13-2-06199-6 KNT. One week later, Gronquist filed an amended petition for writs of mandamus and certiorari directing DOC to process and approve his release plan. He also requested costs and attorney fees. In response, DOC presented evidence to refute Gronquist's claims and asked the court to transfer the matter to this court for consideration as a personal restraint petition. After the trial court transferred the matter to this court, Gronquist filed a motion for discretionary review of the transfer order. After briefing was complete, a commissioner of this court submitted the matter to the Acting Chief Judge for resolution "within the context of a personal restraint petition."

As an initial matter, Gronquist fails to demonstrate error in the trial court's order transferring his petition to this court for consideration as a personal restraint petition. Because Gronquist's petition could be viewed as a request for postconviction relief, the superior court did not abuse its discretion by refusing to

issue the requested writs and transferring the matter to this court. See, RCW 7.16.040; RCW 7.16.170; Toliver v. Olsen, 109 Wn.2d 607, 746 P.2d 809 (1987); Dress v. Washington State Dept. of Corrections, 168 Wn. App. 319, 337-38, 279 P.3d 875 (2012) (whether there is an adequate remedy in ordinary course of law is within sound discretion of court within which writ is sought); In re Pers. Restraint of Liptrap, 127 Wn. App. 463, 111 P.3d 1227 (2005) (abrogated on other grounds by In re Pers. Restraint of Mattson, 166 Wn.2d 730, 740-41, 214, P.3d 141 (2009)) (where inmates filed petition for writ of mandamus seeking order directing DOC to approve release or parole plans, Supreme Court converted the action to a personal restraint petition).

As to the merits, to obtain collateral relief by means of a personal restraint petition, Gronquist must demonstrate that he is being unlawfully restrained. See In re Pers. Restraint of Cashaw, 123 Wn.2d 138, 148-49, 866 P.2d 8 (1994); RAP 16.4. Gronquist claimed in his initial petition that DOC had failed to review his proposed residence, the Boylston Hotel, within 30 days of the submission of his release plan as required by DOC Policy 350.200 and still had not done so as of the date he filed his petition. In response, DOC presented records indicating that community custody officers investigated the Boylston Hotel and other residences proposed by Gronquist. In his memorandum in support of his amended petition, Gronquist claimed that a DOC officer informed him that the officer who rejected the Boylston Hotel did not have a legitimate basis for his decision and that no community custody officer would approve any proposed residence for him.



To the extent Gronquist sought an order directing DOC to process his submission of the Boylston Hotel as a potential release address, his claim is moot. See In re Pers. Restraint of Cross, 99 Wn.2d 373, 376-77, 662 P.2d 828 (1983) (a claim is moot if the court can provide no effective relief). To the extent he still seeks an order directing DOC to approve any other particular address, Gronquist fails to “demonstrate that he has competent, admissible evidence to establish the facts that entitle him to relief.” In re Pers. Restraint of Rice, 118 Wn.2d 876, 886, 828 P.2d 1086 (1992). DOC Policy 350.200 does not require approval of any particular release plan, but requires officers to use “risk based offender management principles” and follow a certain procedure to determine “the appropriateness” of a plan based on limitations in an offender’s judgment and sentence. Gronquist’s speculation that DOC personnel rejected the Boylston Hotel on an improper basis or will never approve of any address does not entitle him to relief by means of a personal restraint petition.

Now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED that the personal restraint petition is dismissed under RAP 16.11(b).

The release plan itself consists of an undeveloped piece of property in rural Ferry County. There are no power services on the property. There is no septic on the property. There is no well on the property. According to Ferry County, no permitting processes have even been started for any of these services. Mr. Gronquist family has offered to park a recreational vehicle on the property until services are installed and a more permanent structure can be erected. The time frame for having a permanent, self-sustaining structure being put on the property is unknown. In my experience with this area, the plan to reside in an RV under the current circumstances is not a viable, sustainable situation. While Mr. Gronquist family is willing to at least temporary live on the property and assist with Mr. Gronquist, they do not currently live in the region. The family could provide Mr. Gronquist the same support anywhere to include the county of origin. Ferry County is not Mr. Gronquist's county of origin. There are four exceptions which allow an offender to release to a county other than the county of first felony conviction; however, Mr. Gronquist case does not meet any of those exceptions. The judgment and sentence does not restrict Mr. Gronquist from returning to the county of origin. There are no significant victim's safety issues precluding Gronquist from returning to the county of origin. There are no reasons for concern about negative influences on the offender in the county of origin as he acted alone in his offenses. The fourth exception being the presence of family or sponsoring organizations willing to support the offender, also does not exist based on the information above. There is only a vacant lot. Other concerns exist as well. This plan was previously denied in part because GPS could not be used in this area. To my knowledge, there are school bus stops on Boulder Road. The property is also located in a rural region where children are allowed to remain unsupervised in the community for extended periods of time. The elementary school is located at the base of Boulder Road and there are several recreational areas nearby frequented by minors. Also, it is unknown if Mr. Gronquist is amenable to treatment or if the local sex offender treatment provider will accept him as a client.

ORP does not meet 6157 exception criteria. There are no sponsoring persons or organizations at the ORP address or in the area. It is currently an undeveloped lot with not even the basic utilities. This address was previously submitted and denied. There have been no changes made to the property since the previous ORP, other than a street address getting assigned. The offender's crime date precludes him from being supervised by GPS by policy and the offender has challenged this as well. This would only allow him to be unmonitored in a remote area with very limited and lengthy response time from area law enforcement should he re-offend in a similar manner. He has been determined to be a predatory sex offender that is highly likely to re-offend. This plan puts the community at risk due to the extensive travelling he would be engaged in at this address just to report, attend treatment, and get basic supplies. He would also be going past several places minors congregate. Adequate monitoring and supervision can not be provided at this remote location.


1. I am a legal secretary with the Corrections division of the Attorney General's Office in Olympia, Washington. I have knowledge of the facts stated herein and am competent to testify.
