Dear Ms. Carlson,

In reviewing the supplemental briefs filed in this case, I discovered an error in the Respondents'. I would appreciate it if you would pass this correction on to the Court.

In the statement of facts, on page 2, the Department stated that "Southwick adopted its current business rules in July 2011, including a new rule to address 'correction of errors' in interments." This sentence should be corrected to remove the word "new" as the "correction of errors" rule was included in Southwick's 1997 rules. In July 2011, the rule was reissued without alteration. This correction does not change or effect the Department's position or legal arguments, but I want to correct this misstatement.
