Additional Ground V

On the day I was ARRESTED, during the SEARCH the ARRESTING officer found a meth pipe in my bag which he held up in his hand and stated "I am going to throw this AWAY."

During my trial this same officer testified under oath that he had not found NO DRUGS OR PARAPHERNALIA ON MY PERSON OR IN MY PROPERTY.
