1) No.: 35297-8-III Case Name: State of Washington v. Chad G. Bennett County: Grant

Case Summary: The State charged Chad Bennett with murder in the first degree for the death of Lucille Moore. At trial, the superior court excluded Mr. Bennett's proffered other suspect evidence. A jury found him guilty of the lesser crime of murder in the second degree and multiple aggravating factors. The superior court imposed an upward exceptional sentence, and denied a post-trial motion to dismiss for government mismanagement stemming from the State's late testing of evidence and late disclosure of Mr. Bennett's jail calls. Mr. Bennett appeals these matters and also raises claims of prosecutorial misconduct during closing argument.
