Case Summary: J.S. appeals the termination of his parental rights to his child. During the termination proceedings, Mr. S. raised issues concerning the State's compliance with the federal and state Indian Child Welfare Acts, 25 U.S.C. §§ 1901-1963 and RCW ch. 13.38. Mr. S. also challenged the State's proof concerning the other elements of RCW 13.34.180(1) and RCW 13.34.190(1).
