SB 5866 (link below) would reduce certain prison sentences 60 to 120 days depending on the offender's recidivism risk level and excluding sentences for sex offenses, murder 1 & 2, and life without parole. Furthermore, it would reinvest 50% of the savings in evidence-based programs using the WSIPP model.

The EBCC has been working on an endorsement letter to submit to the legislature in support of the WSIPP cost-benefit model. I have sent this letter out to all of you before, but I am attaching it again and asking for any additional comments and a final vote via email as to whether we can submit this letter now as the legislature considers this relevant bill.
