Please see attached revised bill that Rep. Pederson is putting forward in committee's exec. session tomorrow. He struck all the worst parts of the bill. The mandatory hearing and the shifting of the burden of proof to the guardian and the distinction between lay and professional guardian are all removed.

Rep. Pederson is asking for feedback on what is left, including a change (he hopes clarification) to the language in Section 1. These changes were not in Sen. Kastama's bill, but Rep. Pederson believes that it makes it more clear. I agree with him.

The deadline for changes in the bill they submit to the committee is 4 PM today and the executive session is 10 AM tomorrow. So if you want to have input it has to be on a fast track.
