

## Guardianship Program Rules

### 301 Purpose and Procedure

301.1. The Certified Professional Guardian Board (Board) may issue written ethics advisory opinions for Certified Professional Guardians (Guardians) and Certified Professional Guardian Agencies (Agencies).

301.2 Any Guardian, Agency, or Board member may request in writing that the Board issue an ethics advisory opinion regarding the application of the Standards of Practice to a specific factual circumstance. (Amended 3-09-09)

301.3 A request for an ethics advisory opinion is confidential and not public information.
