A. <u>IDENTITY OF MOVING PARTY AND RELIEF SOUGHT</u>

Melvin Xavier respectfully requests this Court stay consideration of his petition for review pending this Court's resolution of <u>State v.</u>

<u>Vasquez.</u> Mr. Xavier makes this motion in the interest of justice and pursuant to RAP 1.2(c), RAP 7.3, and RAP 17.1(a).

B. GROUNDS FOR RELIEF AND ARGUMENT

Among the issues of which Mr. Xavier seeks this Court's review is whether the trial court misunderstood its discretion at his resentencing when it told Mr. Xavier it could not consider mitigation evidence and failed to conduct a de novo sentencing proceeding. This Court has accepted review a case that addresses the scope of resentencing proceedings: State v. Vasquez, No. 102045-7. This case is scheduled for argument in this Court on February 15, 2024. Mr. Xavier cited Vasquez in a Statement of Additional Authorities filed on December 21, 2023.

Staying Mr. Xavier's petition would conserve judicial resources and ensure equitable review. Given that <u>Vasquez</u> will require this Court to address the scope of a trial court's discretion to consider mitigating evidence at resentencing hearings, it is in the interest of justice to stay Mr. Xavier's case until the Court resolves that case.
