DECLARATION OF PENNY WORSHAM

I, Penny Worsham, do state:

1. From *Penny Worsham*, I was an official court reporter for Spokane Superior Court. I am now retired.
2. At the time I was a court reporter for Spokane County, my name was Penny Rauschke. I have since remarried.
3. On March 15, 2012, I was contacted by Lynda Zeis, a paralegal at the Law Offices of Sheryl Gordon McCloud, to order the transcripts from three proceedings from the case of *State v. Marquis Jones*, Spokane County Superior Court No. 00-1-00934-9: April 27, 2000 (Initial Arraignment before Judge Gregory D. Sypolt); August 31, 2000 (Motion to Amend Information before Judge Tari S.
