I, Jerry Allen Herron, have received and reviewed the opening brief prepared by my attorney. Summarized below are the additional grounds for review that are not addressed in that brief. I understand the Court will review this State of Additional Grounds for Review when my appeal is considered on the merits.

Additional Ground 1

On approximately June 14, 2007, I filed a Motion in Limine for an order allowing evidence of juvenile adjucations for a Theft 3 charge and a Vehicle Prowl 2 charge of witness Kristen Beck. The basis of the Motion was ER 609(d) since conviction on these offenses would be admissible to attack the credibility of an adult, and the admission of the evidence was necessary for a fair determination of my guilt of innocence. A critical issue at trial was the credibility of the alleged victim, Kristin Beck (formerly Wooltering). Evidence of adjudications on these charges would have been important impeachment evidence, especially given the fact that she had a history of not telling the police the truth. The court improperly denied this motion and disallowed evidence of those two adjudications at trial.

Additional Ground 2

I proposed a jury instruction for Assault in the Fourth Degree. The court disallowed that jury instruction. I think the jury could have found an assault occurred rather than a rape.
