Petition

I, James Gray, am petitioning the Supreme Court for discretionary review for the following reasons.

I filed my appeal in a timely manner with the Whitman Co. clerks office on April 30, 2012. Whitman Co. concealed they had in fact buried and misplaced the appeal for 45 days, despite my repeated efforts to follow the progress of my appeal.

The appellate court received a brief from the attorney I hired, to which no response from Ms. Martin was received. However, she was granted repeated continuances or extensions to respond to the brief. No response was ever received.

The appellate court returned the case to the superior courts September 2013 for a finding of facts, to which Ms. Martin appeared after being served. Ms. Martin failed to comply with the court in the matter of finding of facts and argued it to be a moot point. I refiled the appeal the same day in September 2013.

As of September 2013, the year and order had been expired dated March, 2013.

It is my position, had the courts proceeded in a timely matter this would not have been a moot point. The finding of facts would have shown the court had erroneously granted Martins order due to the fact that her evidence did not meet the RCW for harassment or fear of intimate danger.

At this juncture, I am requesting a discretionary review of the denied motion to modify received from the appellate court.

I pray a review of facts will find the lower courts malfeasance in the adjudication of the facts and the Superior courts will over turn this decision.
