

STATEMENT OF ADDITIONAL
GROUNDS FOR REVIEW

I, Brian Thompson, have received and reviewed the opening brief prepared by my attorney. Summarized below are the additional grounds for review that are not addressed in that brief. I understand the Court will review this Statement of Additional Grounds for Review when my appeal is considered on the merits.

Additional Ground 1

Officer Tony Shelton was Allowed To Remain in the Court room during Jury Selection and throughout all testimony at the prosecutions table under the guild of Investigator for the State He Should not have been Allowed to Testify at the end of the trial having heard all prior testimony.

Additional Ground 2
