Appellant hereby requests an extension of time to timely file for DISCRETIONARY REVIEW OF DECISION TERMINATING REVIEW, so that Appellant would be able to pursue his livelihood during this crucial time of the year.

**IV. GROUNDS FOR RELIEF AND ARGUMENT**


Due to the timing of this Order dated July 8, 2015, and the timing of Appellants income and substance, and additional 30 days (including the statutory 30 days) should be granted.
