A public employer's decision to layoff as the result of a budget and staffing reduction is not amenable to collective bargaining, nor is the decision to layoff amenable to a remedy in interest arbitration. However, a public employer must bargain the impacts of the decision to layoff, and may engage in permissive bargaining.

A bargained for provision in a collective bargaining agreement and the civil service rules which mandate when layoffs may occur and the process for layoffs survive the expiration of the contract. If the Court holds that layoffs due to a budget reduction are a mandatory subject of bargaining, then the public employer's affirmative defense that the union has waived bargaining the decision to layoff is valid.

For the reasons set forth above, the Petitioner, Kitsap County, respectfully requests that the Court accept review.
