I, Deborah J. Ljunghammar, have received and reviewed the opening brief prepared by my attorney. Summarized below are the additional grounds for review that are not addressed in that brief. I understand the Court will review this Statement of Additional Grounds for Review when my appeal is considered on the merits.

Additional Ground 1

Ivan Ljunghammar's civil confession of judgment prejudiced the jury against me. Ivan admitted to a civil responsibility. Not a criminal act. Ivan didn't keep records well enough to prove why he was being paid by Shelarose. This proves that he wasn't conscientious enough in his record keeping. But the prosecutor, in his closing statements, refers to that confession of judgment as a confession of a crime leaving the JURY thinking that Ivan and my self by association, had admitted to stealing from Shelarose.

Additional Ground 2

The courts decision to try us together instead of separately, prejudiced the jury against me, even though I was never responsible for Shelarose's estate. Legally there is a big difference between "Ivan put money into our joint checking account and didn't have receipts to justify that money" and Ivan & Deborah stole from Shelarose but for the average person, there is not much difference, and in trying me with Ivan, the state was able to blur those lines in the minds of the jury, to convict me without even presenting evidence against me.
