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A. IDENTITY OF RESPONDENT

The State of Washington is the Respondent in this case.

B. COURT OF APPEALS DECISION

The Court of Appeals decision at issue is In re the Parentage of S.J.A., State of Washington v. Alemayehu Arega Jimma, No. 73445-8-1 which was dismissed on April 1, 2016. Petitioner's Motion to Modify the Dismissal was denied on June 28, 2016.

C. ISSUES PRESENTED FOR REVIEW

1. Did the Court of Appeals improperly dismiss Petitioner's Appeal?
2. Is Petitioner entitled to genetic testing when parentage was established more than 13 years previously and he failed to appeal any of the orders entered during the course of that proceeding?
3. Does a child's residency outside of the State prevent the court from entering a child support adjustment order?

**D. STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

The matter currently before the Court originated from a Motion for Child Support Adjustment filed by the King County Prosecutor's Office on September 15, 2014. This case involves one child, S.J.A., who is now 16 years old. The motion for adjustment was based upon the child now being over the age of 12, and that child support had not been adjusted or modified in nine years. RCW 26.09.170; RCW 26.09.175.

After the filing of the motion for support adjustment, Mr. Jimma filed a response in which he requested genetic testing, despite parentage having been established more than 13 years prior to that date. Mr. Jimma also challenged the jurisdiction of the court to enter an order given that the child was residing out of the country.

On December 3, 2014, Commissioner James Kahan entered an order finding that the court had jurisdiction to adjust the underlying child support obligation based upon the prior King County Orders of Child Support, and further finding that parentage was properly adjudicated 14 years previously and no action had been taken by Mr. Jimma to appeal that adjudication. Based upon these findings Mr. Jimma's motion for genetic testing was denied

and the matter set over additional documentation regarding funding provided to the child (CP 80-81).

Mr. Jimma filed a motion of reconsideration of Commissioner Kahan's denial of his motion for genetic testing. The Order on Reconsideration was entered on February 9, 2015 (CP 89-91). The order briefly recited the history of the case starting with the parentage action filed by the State in 2000 including the following pertinent facts:

--the court originally ordered paternity genetic testing (CP 17-19),

--that the parties chose to forego the genetic testing and signed, instead, an Agreed Order Determining Parentage entered January 27, 2001 (CP 21-22),

--a Partial Summary Judgment and Temporary Order of Child Support were entered on August 9, 2001, finding Mr. Jimma to be the child's father. Mr. Jimma had sought genetic testing at the Summary Judgment hearing but was denied and he failed to file any appeal of that ruling,

--on November 16, 2001, a Judgment and Order Determining Parentage was entered in which Mr. Jimma was again found to be the father of the child. Mr. Jimma did not file any revision, appeal or motion to vacate any of these orders.

--In 2004, Mr. Jimma, through counsel, filed a Petition to Modify Child Support in which he identified himself as the father of the child. The matter was resolved by agreement with orders entered on March 15, 2005

(CP 78-79). The documents filed reflected that the child lived in Ethiopia with a third party.

The court found that based upon the numerous prior orders in the case which established jurisdiction over the parties and parentage of the child, none of which orders were timely challenged, and which orders also stated the child was residing in Ethiopia, and the court's continuing jurisdiction over Mr. Jimma and Ms. Tsegaye given they both live in King County, Mr. Jimma's motion for reconsideration should be denied.

Following the denial of the motion for reconsideration the Order on Adjustment and Order of Child Support were entered by the court on April 15, 2015 (CP 96-112).

During the course of the adjustment proceeding Mr. Jimma was granted five continuances, spanning a period of time between October 15, 2014 and April 14, 2015. During these six months, Mr. Jimma failed to provide financial information from his occupation as a taxi driver to assist the Court in setting accurate income to determine child support. Mr. Jimma improperly challenged paternity within the Motion to Adjust Child Support and revised the Family Court Commissioner's ruling on that issue. The trial court heard argument that Mr. Jimma was requesting DNA

testing as an obstructive tactic in finalizing his child support obligation.

This pattern of delay has continued at the appellate level. A Notice of Appeal was received by the Court of Appeals on May 11, 2015. Mr. Jimma had until October 22, 2015 to file and serve his designation of clerk's papers. Mr. Jimma filed a Designation of Clerk's Papers on October 15, 2015, which Designation was rejected by the King County Clerk's Office for failure to comply with RAP 9.6(b)(2). Mr. Jimma then filed an Amended Designation of Clerk's Papers on November 30, 2015, but failed to list the State as a party entitled to the Index of Clerk's Papers.

On December 23, 2015, Mr. Jimma provided a statement indicating he would not be providing a verbatim transcript but had arranged for someone to create a Narrative of Proceedings, a copy of which would be delivered to the Court of Appeals. Again, Mr. Jimma did not arrange for the State as a Respondent in this appeal to receive a copy of the Narrative.

On February 19, 2016, the Court of Appeals sent notice that the record on appeal was not complete and if Mr. Jimma did not complete the record by March 21, 2016, the matter would be subject to dismissal. Mr. Jimma responded requesting an

additional 60 days to provide the needed document but on April 1, 2016, the Court of Appeals dismissed the appeal for failure to meet the case deadlines.

Mr. Jimma filed a statement challenging the dismissal which was interpreted by the court as a motion to modify the ruling. The State filed a Response to this motion on April 26, 2016. On June 28, 2016, the Court of Appeals entered an Order Denying Motion to Modify referencing RAP 17.7. To date, no narrative of the proceedings has been provided.

In the summer of 2015, Mr. Jimma had petitioned the Court for the expenditure of public funds to assist in his appeal. As one of his exhibits, he provided a statement from a paralegal for \$2900.00 stamped "Paid in Full" itemizing his efforts for the appeal **(Attachment to EXHIBIT A)**. The Court of Appeals denied his request for public funds on September 2, 2015. In the 18 months since the modified Order of Child support was entered, Mr. Jimma has only paid a total of \$363.66 in child support despite the Court ordering him to pay \$632.00 per month. Nine out of the twelve payments made after April 30, 2015 were for \$25.00 **(Attachment to EXHIBIT A)**.

E. ARGUMENT WHY REVIEW SHOULD BE DENIED

The State submits that Mr. Jimma is using the issue of DNA testing as an obstructive tactic in preventing the increase of his child support to an appropriate level. Mr. Jimma is a sophisticated participant in the legal system, in this case and others, and is engaging in frivolous and specious arguments to distract the Court from his own unimpressive behaviors.

This matter was before the court for a simple motion to adjust child support. The only issues before the court were the incomes of the parties, the standard calculation of child support, whether either party was entitled to a deviation and what percentage responsibility each parent had for various expenses for the child. Mr. Jimma delayed the final decision in the adjustment proceeding from October 2014, to April 2015, with an untimely request for genetic testing on a matter that is res judicata.

He is now extending the appeal by every means necessary to avoid his obligation to support his child. He has provided no law supporting his actions or supporting his argument for relief. He has been treated very patiently by the trial court and the Court of Appeals but at some point there needs to be finality.

Paternity of this child was established in 2001, based upon an Agreed Order of Parentage signed by both the father and the mother. A few months after that order had been entered, Mr. Jimma requested genetic testing at the time child support was to be determined but his request was denied. Mr. Jimma did not file a motion for reconsideration, a motion for revision or a formal appeal to the Court of Appeals of the resulting order. In November of that year, the final orders were entered following a trial before Judge Barnett. Again Mr. Jimma did not file an appeal from that ruling. An interpreter was provided to Mr. Jimma during these proceedings so his lack of ability to speak and understand English was not at issue. Pursuant to RAP 5.2(a), a Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days of the entry of a final order in a case. Mr. Jimma does not provide any legal basis supporting his allegation that he should be allowed genetic testing 16 years after the action was initiated. The parties and the child are entitled to finality on the matter. While there is a constitutional right to genetic testing, he waived that right choosing to admit paternity rather than participate in the genetic testing that had already been ordered by the court.

In 2005, Mr. Jimma, through the assistance of counsel, filed a Petition to Modify Child Support. Mr. Jimma did not file a CR 60 motion to vacate the underlying order. Instead, in reliance on the underlying order, he sought to modify the amount he was ordered to pay and was able to get the amount reduced to \$25 per month. It is only now with the recent motion to increase his support obligation that he is raising this issue that has long been settled. This is analogous to a father who has signed a parentage affidavit seeking to challenge that parentage establishment 16 years after it was established. The law only allows such a challenge to occur if filed within four years after the acknowledgment has been filed with the state registrar of vital records. RCW 26.26.335. There is no basis for an individual who waived his right to genetic testing in signing an Order admitting to parentage and failed to seek appeal of any of the orders establishing him as this child's father to be able to re-open the issue of parentage 16 years later.

The parties and the Court relied upon this adjudication when the case was voluntarily modified in 2005. In that modification, support was reduced from \$296 to \$25.00 per month. Mr. Jimma did not challenge paternity when the numbers were reduced in his favor.

Jurisdiction is not an issue in this case. The Court properly had jurisdiction to enter the paternity order in 2001 because all parties were living in King County. In fact, the Court signed orders which confirmed that it had jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of the parentage action on February 1, 2001, and confirmed proper jurisdiction again on November 6, 2001, March 15, 2005, February 9, 2015, and April 15, 2015. Mr. Jimma did not seek appeal of any of the prior orders before the most recent Order on Adjustment.

Mr. Jimma's argument that the court no longer has jurisdiction because the child was residing in Ethiopia is belied by his own action for modification which reduced his support to \$25 per month with full knowledge of the child being in Ethiopia.

RCW 26.26.160(1) provides that the court has continuing jurisdiction to modify the orders entered for future education and support. Mr. Jimma has not provided any authority challenging this provision.

F. CONCLUSION

The petition should be denied for the reasons set out above. This appeal is the latest in a long course of Mr. Jimma's efforts to

delay this matter and avoid his legal responsibilities. The child in this case, S.J.A., deserves some finality on this issue and the mother has been subjected to needless and toxic litigation on this issue.

If the Court finds that the appeal was improperly dismissed, the State would like the opportunity to fully respond. This requires that the State be served with all pleadings including the Clerk's Papers and the Narrative Report of Proceedings so the State has the opportunity to supplement the record.

The State of Washington respectfully objects to Appellant's motion to modify the ruling signed by Richard D. Johnson on April 1, 2016 dismissing the appeal.

The Appellant has been granted numerous continuances throughout this case, both at the trial level and the appellate level. The original date of the Motion to Adjust Child Support was 10/15/14. At the appellant's request, it was continued to 10/29/14, then 12/3/14, to address the issue of paternity which had been adjudicated nine years prior. The Appellant then filed a Motion for Reconsideration on 1/5/15 which the Court denied on 2/9/15. At the Family Law Commissioner's instruction, the State pursued the Motion for Adjustment, which had been continued to 3/4/15. That hearing was continued to 4/15/15 because the Appellant failed to appear on 3/4/15 and final documents were ultimately entered on 4/15/15 (Appellant failed to appear again).

A notice of appeal was received by the Court of Appeals on 5/11/15. The Appellant had until 10/22/15 to file and serve his designation of clerk's papers. He failed to meet that deadline. The Court of Appeals granted him an extension of five months until 3/21/15 and the Appellant, again, failed to meet that deadline. In the intervening period of time, the Appellant petitioned the court for the expenditure of public funds to assist in his appeal. As one of his exhibits, he provided a statement from a paralegal for \$2900 stamped "paid-in-full" itemizing his efforts on this appeal. In the 12 months since the modified Order of Child Support was entered, the Appellant has only paid a total of \$250 in child support when the Court ordered him to pay \$632 per month. The Appellant is a very sophisticated participant in the legal system (in this case and others) and should be held to the same standard as a represented Appellant.

The State of Washington submits that the Appellant has been given many chances and many continuances in this case. Based on his pattern with the trial court and the Court of Appeals, it is questionable whether the Appellant is acting in good faith.
