STATEMENT OF ADDITIONAL
GROUNDS FOR REVIEW

I, Jeffrey Johnson, have received and reviewed the opening brief prepared by my attorney. Summarized below are the additional grounds for review that are not addressed in that brief. I understand the Court will review this Statement of Additional Grounds for Review when my appeal is considered on the merits.

Additional Ground 1

Deputy Kimsey was the only officer with official jurisdiction at Johnson's residence. However, he was not present at the time of Johnson signing the Ferrier warnings only two Centralia Police Officers who were clearly out of their jurisdiction. This is a violation of the law, therefore, the search that preceded the signing of the Ferrier warnings would be considered invalid.

Additional Ground 2

When officers conduct a "knock and talk" it is considered unlawful to enter areas of the property other than the residence with an official address posted thereon. The barn is positioned approximately 200 feet behind the residence this places the officers in direct violation of a knock and talk.
