## 1. PERSON FILING THE MOTION

This motion is filed by Petitioners, Allan and Gina Margitan, through undersigned counsel.

## 2. RELIEF REQUESTED

Petitioners request that the Court accept their Second Amended Petifion for Discretionary Review.

## 3. FACTS RELEVANT TO MOTION

Petitioners received Respondents' objection to the length of their petition on October 18, 2018; that same day, Petitioners' counsel immediately filed an Amended Petition for Discretionary Review that was shortened to 20 pages in response. This document was filed prior to receiving the letter from the Supreme Court Deputy Clerk, dated October 19,2018, which indicated that the Court expects parties to append copies of the decisions on review. That document indicated that the Petitioner may serve and file an amended petition for review by November 2, 2018.

The Second Amended Petition for Discretionary Review includes copies of those decisions as Appendix I and Appendix 2 and was further shortened by approximately a page and a half for a total of approximately 18.5 pages.

## 4. GROUNDS FOR RELIEF

RAP 18.8(a) authorizes the Court to waive or alter provisions of any of the rules in order to serve the ends of justice. The Second Amended Petition
for Discretionary Review has been submitted for the purposes of complying with the Clerk's letter requesting that Petitioners append copies of the decisions being reviewed and to address the issue raised by Respondents regarding length.

Because Petitioners were granted the opportunity to file an amended document by November 2, 2018, and both documents were filed prior to that deadline, Petitioners request that the Court accept the Second Amended Petition for Discretionary Review as their amended petition rather than the Amended Petition for Discretionary Review.

Should the Court decide not to grant this motion, Petitioners withdraw their Second Amended Petilion for Discretionary Review and rely on their Amended Petition for Discretionary Review filed on October 18, 2018.
