
WHEREAS, Benton County has declared an emergency in response to COVID-19,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, until further notice and effective Thursday, March 19, 2020:

1. All defendants arrested/cited for misdemeanor and gross misdemeanor crimes, except for Domestic Violence crimes and DUI/Physical Control crimes, will be set for court dates after April 24, 2020, and released on their personal recognizance.
2. Any outstanding bench warrants on misdemeanor and gross misdemeanor crimes, except for Domestic Violence crimes and DUI/Physical Control crimes, shall not be served on defendants until after April 24, 2020.

This emergency order does not impact Domestic Violence crimes and DUI/Physical Control crimes.
