This matter comes before the Court on the public health emergency in Washington State and Clallam County:

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2020 this Court entered Administrative Order No. 2020-01 regarding court operations during the present public health emergency due to the COVID-19 virus, and


WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020 Washington State Supreme Court Chief Justice Debra Stevens entered Administrative Order No. 2020-01, granting emergency authority to the Presiding Judges of Washington courts to adopt, modify, and/or suspend court rules, and to take further actions concerning court operations as needed to respond to the public health emergency. The Court incorporates said Order by reference.

Based on the preceding, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Any provision of this Court's Administrative Order No. 2020-01 which materially conflicts with Washington State Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2020-01 (as presently written or subsequently amended) are hereby rescinded. All other provisions of Administrative Order No. 2020-01 remain in full force and effect.

2. This Administrative Order shall remain in effect until rescinded.
