
WHEREAS, The Chief Justice has issued an emergency order in response to the public health emergency that affects operations of trial courts in Washington State on March 4, 2020 and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Supreme Court has adopted Order No. 25700-B-602, granting emergency authority to this court to adopt, modify, and suspend court rules and orders, and to take further actions concerning court operations, as warranted to address the current state of emergency; and in recognition of the Grays Harbor Superior Court's emergency order dated March 12, 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The provision of CrRLJ 3.3. CrRLJ 3.4 and IRLJ 2.6 pertaining to time limits and presence of the defendant are hereby suspended until further order of this court.
2. All criminal jury trials scheduled from now through April 2, 2020 will be continued and rescheduled to the week of April 27, 2020. This will be an excluded period for computing the time for trial.
3. This order will be reviewed no later than April 15, 2020.
