## NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1. The provision of CrRLJ 3.3. CrRLJ 3.4 and IRLJ 2.6 pertaining to time limits and presence of the defendant are hereby suspended until further order of this court.
- 2. All criminal jury trials scheduled from now through April 2, 2020 will be continued and rescheduled to the week of April 27, 2020. This will be an excluded period for computing the time for trial.
- 3. This order will be reviewed no later than April 15, 2020.
