


3. To effectuate these continuances implemented by this Administrative Order, CrRLJ 3.3, the Time for Trial Rule for criminal matters, CrRLJ 4.1 time for arraignment and time for hearing on civil infractions under IRLJ 2.6 are hereby suspended. The Court specifically finds the ends of justice served by the continuance outweighs the best interest of the public and defendant's right to a speedy trial due to the unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances cause by the above enunciated public health emergency.
4. Probation appointments will be conducted by telephone only.
5. The prosecutor and public defender will remain on call and available for court appearances as coordinated.
6. The Court will assess the need for further continuances and setting or jury trials for the month of April on or before April 1, 2020.
