THIS MATTER has come before the Court Sua Sponte, the Court finds as follows:


On March 19, 2020, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Washington issued an emergency order in response to the public health emergency that affects operations of trial courts in Washington State. In addition to other provisions, the Order suspends all civil jury trials and all non-emergency civil (including domestic) matters until after April 24, 2020;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. **Prior Order Terminated.** This Order replaces the Order of this Court of March 16, 2020, which is now terminated.
2. **Non-emergency Civil and Domestic Matters.** The Court is continuing all non-emergency Civil and Domestic matters previously scheduled between the date of this order and April 24, 2020, as set forth in Attachment A and incorporated by this reference.
3. **Emergency Civil and Domestic Matters.** All parties and their representatives on emergency Civil and Domestic matters will appear telephonically at times and dates to be scheduled by the Court. Unless otherwise directed by the Court, the parties shall contact Court Administration by telephone at (360) 427-8440 or (360) 427-9670, ext 348, no later than 30 minutes before the scheduled hearing for further contact information.

4. **Daily Protection Order Dockets.** The Court will maintain the daily Protection Order Docket to be held at 9:00 a.m., Monday through Friday. Parties will appear telephonically at the initial scheduled hearing. Unless otherwise directed by the Court, the parties shall contact Court Administration by telephone at (360) 427-8440 or (360) 427-9670, ext 348, no later than 8:30 a.m. on the day of the hearing for further contact information. Issues related to telephonic appearances and testimony regarding evidentiary hearings on Petitions for Protection Orders will be decided by the judicial officer assigned to the case.
