SUPPLEMENT  
Effective APRIL 27, 2020

On February 29, 2020, Governor Jay Inslee declared a state of emergency in all counties in the state of Washington due to the public health emergency caused by the Coronavirus Disease 2019 ("COVID-19") and issued orders to limit the transmittal of the disease. The Order has been extended through May 4, 2020, and may be extended or be modified due to the continued danger to public health.

Based on the continued emergency, the Court is issuing the following supplemental orders:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:


All restrictions set out in Order 2020-1 dated March 17, 2020, shall remain in effect, EXCEPT:

- 1. Beginning May 1, 2020, all regular dockets will resume as virtual hearings via ZOOM;

All hearings noted on regular dockets after May 1, 2020; the Notice of Hearings must be served on the other party, including information that the hearing will be conducted via Zoom and to contact Pacific County Superior Court Administration or visit the Pacific County Government Website, Superior Court, for information, instructions and the Zoom link.
3. All jury trials scheduled through May 31, 2020, are hereby stricken, and all trials will need to be noted by counsel for trial setting.
