PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY ORDER  
REGARDING PIERCE COUNTY  
CORRECTIONS RESTRAINT  
PROCEDURES  
(Amending Emergency Order #9)

WHEREAS: This Court's Emergency Order #9, entered on March 23, 2020 ordered that:

".... Pierce County Corrections Officers transporting in-custody criminal defendants are not required to change restraints in order to escort a defendant into courtrooms. This order shall not extend past April 24, 2020, unless specifically addressed by the Pierce County Superior Court Presiding Judge."

WHEREAS: The public health emergency regarding the risk of transmission of the COVID -19 virus that was the basis for the issuance of Emergency Order 9 has not abated; and

WHEREAS: The Tacoma Pierce County Health Department, the Washington State Department of Health and the Washington State Department of Labor and Industries continue the directives of physical distancing, masking, frequent handwashing, frequent disinfection of surfaces, and similar measures;
